Prunes and Dates For Holiday Fare

Holiday cakes, cookies and bread made with dried fruit are tasty companions for the Thanksgiving or Christmas turkey, says Mrs. Jessie Cartwright, director of the Norge Home Institute.

Here are some of her suggestions:

CALIFORNIA PRUNE CAKE

1-3 cup butter
1 cup sugar
2 eggs
2 cups sifted cake flour
1 teaspoon soda
1/2 teaspoon cinnamon
1/4 teaspoon allspice
1/4 teaspoon cloves
1/2 cup sweet milk
1 cup stewed prunes, stoned and finely cut

Cream the butter. Add the sugar gradually and continue creaming until the mixture is light and fluffy. Beat the eggs until they are foamy. Add them to the creamed mixture and beat thoroughly. Sift the flour with the other dry ingredients. Add flour mixture alternately with the milk to the creamed mixture, combining the ingredients thoroughly. Fold in the prunes and bake in a loaf pan 50 minutes at 350 degrees. When the cake is cool, cover it with a butter icing made of four tablespoons of butter, two cups of confectioner's sugar, one teaspoon vanilla and three tablespoons cream. (Cream the butter, add sugar and cream thoroughly. Then add the vanilla. Stir in a small amount of cream at a time until the mixture is the desired consistency for spreading).

DATE SQUARES

1 pound dates, cut fine
1 cup boiling water
1 cup shortening
2 cups flour
1 1/2 cups brown sugar
1/2 cup orange juice
1 cup rolled oats

Scald the dates with boiling water. Add one-half cup of brown sugar and cook until the mixture thickens. Remove from the heat, add the orange juice and let the filling cool.

Combine shortening, flour, rolled oats, and one cup of brown sugar. Work this crumbed mixture together thoroughly with a pastry blender. Grease the bottom of a 9-inch square cake pan and line it with the crumbed mixture, saving one cup for the topping. Pat the crumbs into the pan firmly with a spoon. Cover with date filling and sprinkle remaining crumbs over the top. Bake at 350 degrees for about 30 minutes.

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AMBER WHIPPED CREAM

As a garnish for your favorite upside down cake, try amber whipped cream made by combining 1/2 cup heavy cream, 1-3 cup firmly packed dark brown sugar and 1/4 teaspoon vanilla. Chill mixture for an hour; then beat until it holds its shape.

WARM WATER

Home economists report that fabrics treated with crease-resistant finishes retain their qualities best when washed in warm, not hot, water. Excessively hot water may remove some of the finish after a number of washings, they warn.
