

### Angel Food Mix Can Be Varied For Double Treats

To make a loaf cake and cup cake from the one package of Angel Food Mix, here are suggestions from the manufacturers, General Foods Corporation.

#### ANGEL FOOD HOLIDAY CAKES

- 1 package (17-ounces) angel food mix
- 3 tablespoons finely-chopped, drained maraschino cherries
- 1-3 cup nuts
- 1 1/4 cups shredded coconut, finely cut

Prepare angel food mix as directed on package. Divide batter in half. Fold cherries and 1 tablespoon of the nuts into one-half of the batter. Pour into ungreased 9x5x3-inch loaf pan. Bake in moderate oven (375 degrees) about 30 minutes or until cake springs back when pressed lightly in center with finger. Cool cake upside down in pan, resting corners on edges of other pans. Let stand until cold—one to two hours. Frost inverted loaf cake and decorate with cherry poinsettias, if desired.

#### CHERRY BUTTER FROSTING

- 6 whole maraschino cherries
- 6 tablespoons butter
- Dash of salt
- 3 cups sifted confectioners' sugar
- 2 tablespoons milk (approximately)
- 1 tablespoon maraschino cherry juice
- 1 teaspoon vanilla

Add whole cherries to butter and cream together; add salt and part of the sugar gradually, blending after each addition. Add remaining sugar alternately with milk and maraschino cherry juice, until of right consistency to spread, beating after each addition until smooth. Add vanilla and blend. If desired, add a few drops of red coloring.

#### CUP CAKES

From the remainder of the batter you have left after putting the

loaf pan in the oven, spoon half the remainder into paper baking cups, filling only two-thirds full. Sprinkle with remaining nuts. Bake on ungreased baking sheet in moderate oven (375 degrees) about 12 minutes. Makes about 15 medium-sized cupcakes.

Fold coconut into remaining batter. Spoon into paper baking cups, filling only two-thirds full. Bake on ungreased baking sheet in 375 degree oven about 12 minutes. Makes about 15 cupcakes.

#### ANGEL FOOD COOKIES

- 1 package (17 ounces) angel food mix
- 1 cup semi-sweet chocolate chips

Prepare angel food mix as directed on package. Divide batter into three parts. Into one part, fold chocolate chips and 1 cup of the nuts. Into second part, fold chopped dates and remaining nuts. Into third part, fold candied ginger, which has been lightly coated with flour. Drop mixtures by tablespoons onto greased and floured baking sheets. Bake in moderate oven (375 degrees) about 12 minutes. When done, remove at once from baking sheets. Makes about 16 dozen cookies.

### Golden Topaz

November's birthstone, the golden topaz, is a clear, glowing emblem of fidelity and true friendship. Sharing this month's birthstones are distinguished persons from both past and present — poet Robert Louis Stevenson, explorer and colonizer Daniel Boone, and beloved New England author Louisa May Alcott. Also celebrating November birthdays are England's Prime Minister Sir Winston Churchill, pianist Jose Iturbi, baseball champion Joe Di Maggio and symphonic conductor Eugene Ormandy.

The word "topaz" comes from the name of an island in the Red Sea called Topazos, meaning "to seek." The ancients found certain yellow-green stones on this island and later all yellow stones were known by the same name — topaz. Today most of the stones the jeweler knows as topaz actually are members of the quartz family, according to the Jewelry Industry Council. Chemically, this stone is a combination of oxygen and silicon and the cause of its color is unknown. It is found in six-sided crystals, most of which come from Brazil. Some call the stone "citrine," topaz quartz or quartz topaz.

Rare precious topaz is different chemically from the quartz variety and has been found in several colors. There is pink and blue topaz, but the golden-brown variety is best-known.

Quartz topaz ranges in color from the palest yellow to deep sherry brown. Adaptable to many types of jewelry for both men and women, the topaz is particularly effective when set in modern multicolored gold mountings. A handsome ring stone, it can be carved into cameo and intaglios. Combinations of two shades are particularly effective.

#### COOL AND COLORFUL

To add to the holiday spirit, freeze some ice cubes with a holly leaf or a few cranberries in each one, says Sara Wallis, home economist for Amara Freezers.
