Montana Reports Official Vote

HELENA, Mont. (U)—The official Montana canvass of votes cast in the Nov. 2 election gave Democratic U.S. Sen. James E. Murray a slim 1,728 plurality over Republican Rep. Wesley A. D'Ewart.
 The canvass, completed yesterday, showed Murray had 114,591 votes. D'Ewart, who gave up his House seat to oppose Murray, counted 112,863.

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
