USC Trojans, Oregon State In Hoop Battles

Southern California and Oregon State, last year's Pacific Coast Conference finalists, collide again this weekend in the Northern Division's feature basketball encounter.

Southern California won the Southern Division title last season, then beat Oregon State, the Northern champion, in the playoffs.

The Trojans rate as slight favorites in the Friday-Saturday games at Corvallis. Southern Cal has its entire championship team back from last season, while the Beavers are playing without Swede Hallbrook, their tall pointmaker who is sitting out the pre-season games because of grade difficulties.

Hinds, ElCamino Meet In Bowl Tilt

PASADENA, Calif. (AP)—Two of the nation's top junior college football teams, Hinds of Mississippi and El Camino of California, meet tomorrow in the ninth annual Junior Rose Bowl Game.

Upwards of 50,000 fans are expected to see the contest, which shapes up as a duel between El Camino's dangerous passing attack and the running tactics of the Mississippi Eagles.

The California team is favored, mainly because it has a remarkable passer in its T-formation quarterback Joe Contestabile.

Hinds' set of backs, however, has dealt misery to all opponents and the team rolled up 3,230 yards for the season and an average per game of 358 yards. El Camino gained 2,019 yards, and 224 per game.

ington travels to Provo, Utah, for a pair with Brigham Young Friday and Saturday nights; Washington State plays Utah State at Pullman Friday night and Whitworth Saturday night, and Idaho tackles Utah State at Moscow Saturday night.
