Wool Use Promotion Plan Asked

SALT LAKE CITY (U)—The National Wool Growers Assn. was urged Thursday to go forward immediately with a promotion program aimed at increasing the consumption of wool and lamb.

It would be financed by a tax of 1 cent per pound on all wool produced in the United States. Growers themselves would pay the tax. But it would come from money due them under the government's new wool incentive price program.

Julian Arrien of Vale, Ore., chairman of the association's resolutions committee, presented the proposal to the final business session of the 90th annual convention.

"We recommend," his committee said, "that the officers of the National Wool Growers Assn. be authorized to cooperate with other organizations in setting up the American Sheep Producers' Council, Inc., and in petitioning the secretary of agriculture to call for a referendum."

North Pole Line To Be Installed

Snow storms are interfering with construction of a special telephone line direct to the North Pole, but the connection is expected to be through sometime next week, according to Bob Griffith, Junior Chamber of Commerce helper on line construction.

When the line is in, children in Klamath Falls will have an opportunity to talk directly with Santa Claus at his headquarters, as has been the custom for some years.

Only certain days, probably December 17, 18 and 19, will be set aside for the "Hello, Santa" program. Other times Santa and Mrs. Claus are working overtime in their workshop getting toys ready for Christmas.

Griffith said that children may write letters to Santa now and address them to the North Pole. Parents are asked to be sure the child's name and return address are clearly indicated on the envelope.

President Of Bend Firm Dies

ST. PAUL, Minn. (U)—Edward Brooks, 66, widely known Minnesota lumber man, died Wednesday of a heart attack at his St. Paul home. For the last 15 years he had been president of Brooks-Scanlon, Inc., with headquarters in Minneapolis and mills at Bend, Ore. He was a director of the Northern Pacific Railway and the Powell River Co., British Columbia, newspaper mill.
