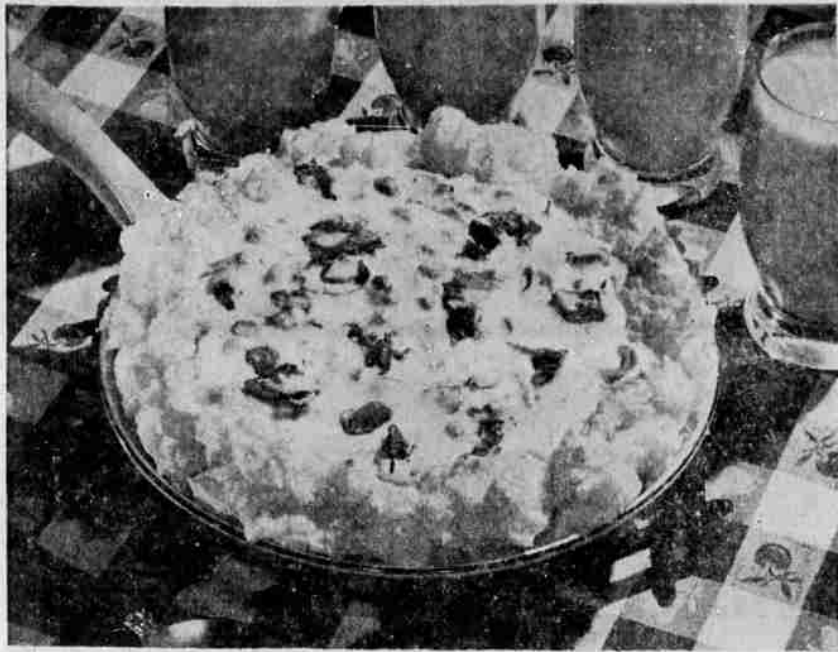

Dinner In a Dish

On busy days when you want to please your family at dinner time and yet have the afternoon free for special projects, an attractive one-dish main course for the evening is time-saving and easy to prepare.

However, the combination of foods and nutritive value should be taken into consideration when the main dish is selected. Many of the most popular casserole dishes are made with milk. This helps insure the necessary nutrients of milk, such as protein, calcium and vitamins in the meal.

Milk, too, helps the flavor of

other foods. Quickie Dried Beef Casserole is flavorful and nutritious. A large crisp green salad and corn muffins with butter would go well with this menu.

If you don't want to fix salad greens, try slicing cabbage very fine and pour over it one cup of pineapple juice and let chill thoroughly before serving.

CASSEROLE

Small can mushrooms (4 oz. stems and pieces)
3 tablespoons butter
3 cups milk

1/2 teaspoon pepper
1/2 pound dried sliced beef
3 cups mashed potatoes (left-over or instant)
1/2 cup shredded cheese
Brown mushrooms in butter; stir in flour and blend until smooth. Slowly add milk and cook, stirring over low heat until sauce is smooth and thickened. Add pepper. Combine with dried beef. Line a buttered 3-quart casserole with mashed potatoes. Fill center with creamed mixture. Sprinkle shredded cheese over potatoes. Bake in moderate oven, 350 degrees, for 25 minutes or until potatoes are lightly brown and creamed mixture is piping hot. Serves six to eight persons.

RECIPE
