



Christmas Tree Ornaments Made With Yuletide Trim Are Fun to Do, Economical

A Christmas tree that's a conversation piece! That's what you can have this year if you make the ornaments yourself out of a handful of props that you have at hand, right now in your kitchen. Inexpensive to make, they are fun for the whole family to create. Best of all, when the holiday season is over, you toss out tree and all into the garbage can.

Who would dream that the same all-purpose detergent you use for washing clothes and dishes can be whipped up into a fascinating, fluffy mixture for making sparkling white Christmas tree ornaments? By combining Tide and plastic starch into a consistency much like thick marshmallow sauce.

Recipe: 1 cup Tide granules, 4 tablespoons plastic starch, 4 cups starch over granules and stir vigorously. When granules are almost dissolved, whip for one minute with egg beater to froth up solution to a consistency much like thick marshmallow sauce.

Assembly Props: Initial step is to assemble a host of odds and ends to serve as the basic props to be spread with or dipped in the mixture.

Dyed toothpicks are piled log-cabin fashion into squares, triangles and star motifs. Secure the Tide trim, applied cement - fashion, and top with sparkle. For another version, dip toothpicks in a thin mix; shake well to remove excess before arranging in pattern.

Nuts, spoons, corks, small bottles, lid discs from jars, steel wool twisted into novel motifs and stiff felt cut-outs are other suggestions.

However, avoid limp props, such as string or rope, discarded dress flowers, etc.

At this point exchange your spoon for an egg beater and whip for one full minute. The last granules disappear and the mix (lighter in texture) looks like a thick marshmallow sauce.

FINISHING: The quicker the ornaments dry the better, so choose a day when humidity is low. It's a good idea to string an overhead wire where you are working, so that as you finish each ornament, there is a place to hang it. Drying time depends upon the consistency of the mixture, how the base absorbs moisture and the humidity in the air. Some ornaments dry in a couple of hours; others overnight.
