NAPLES, Italy (AP)—There are only three organ grinders left here, and one of them is about 11. "Think of it!" says Pasquino Magliano. "Only three organ grinders left in Naples. Doesn't seem possible, does it?" Even at that, Pasquino's hand-cranked mechanical piano doesn't turn out the old songs like "Punicoli, Punicola." His collection lists strongly to American folk music and cowboy ballads. "Once in a while, just for old time's sake," he says, "I put in the wire for one of the old songs, maybe 'O Sole Mio.' Mostly the people in the sidewalk cafes and on the balconies seem to like to hear these new tunes."
