Bad Check Artist On FBI's List

WASHINGTON (AP) - The FBI Monday listed among its "10 Most Wanted Men" Jack Harvey Raymond, 34, transcontinental bad check artist who travels with a girl friend said to be adept in the same line.

The FBI says Raymond has been in trouble with the police since he was a child and has passed checks in no fewer than 20 states as well as several Canadian provinces.

He was convicted for forgery and as an habitual criminal in the state of Washington 18 months ago, but sprung his handcuffs and

fugitive enclosed a rubber check. Raymond usually carries a gun, or guns, and the FBI said Miss Gibbs, 34, is also "possibly armed and should be considered dangerous."

The FBI said Raymond some time ago abandoned his wife and joined forces with ex-convict Helen Virginia Gibbs, who poses as his wife in the swindling of stores where they make purchases by check.

The files note that Raymond in 1954 sent a Christmas card to police at Everett, Wash., reporting "having a wonderful time." The

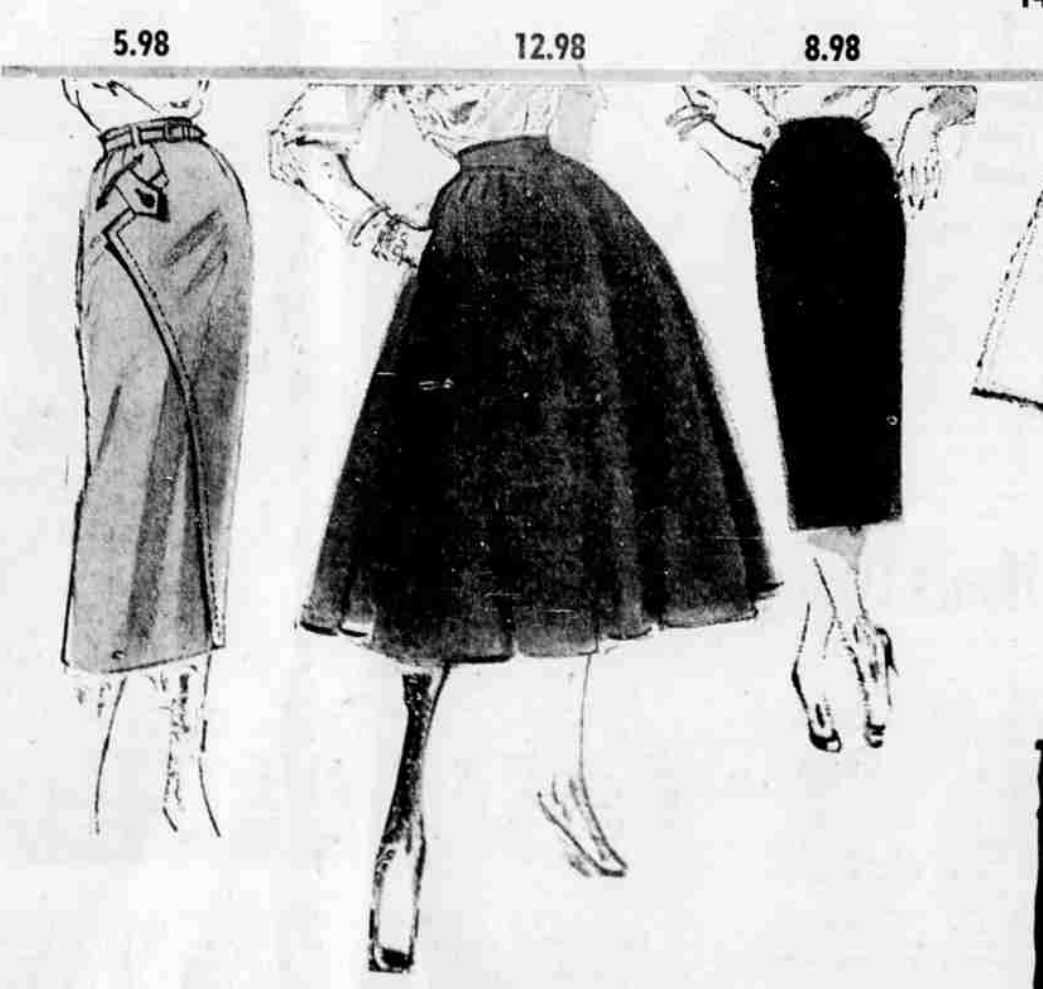
