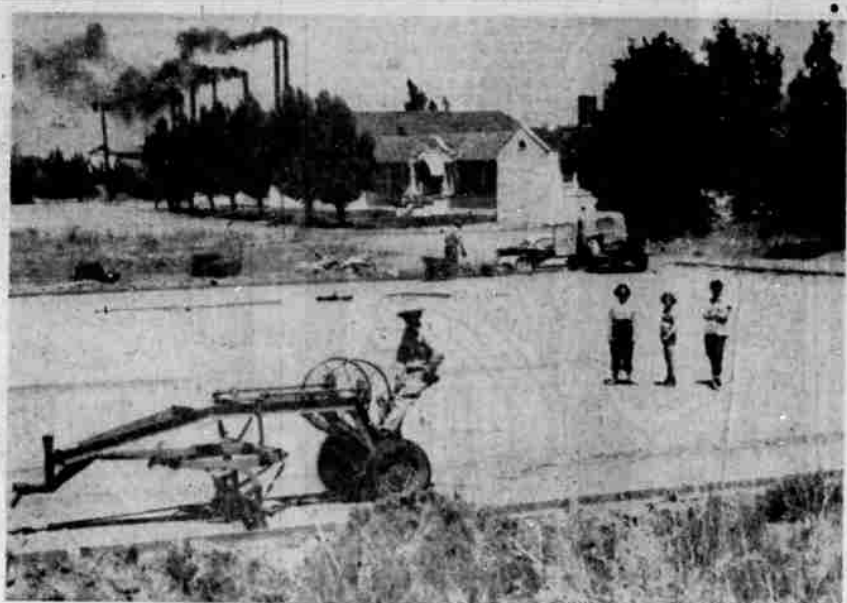

Irrigation operators perform work relating to the regulation, delivery and distribution of irrigation water and the maintenance,

inspection and operation of irrigation systems. Rates of pay range from \$2,960 to \$4,080 per annum. Opportunities for employment are most likely to occur in the vicinity of these locations in California: Antioch, Delano, Friant, Orange Cove, Lindsay, Los Banos, Mendota, Santa Barbara, Visalia, Tracy and Tulare. Some vacancies may also occur in the vicinity of Klamath Falls, Oregon.

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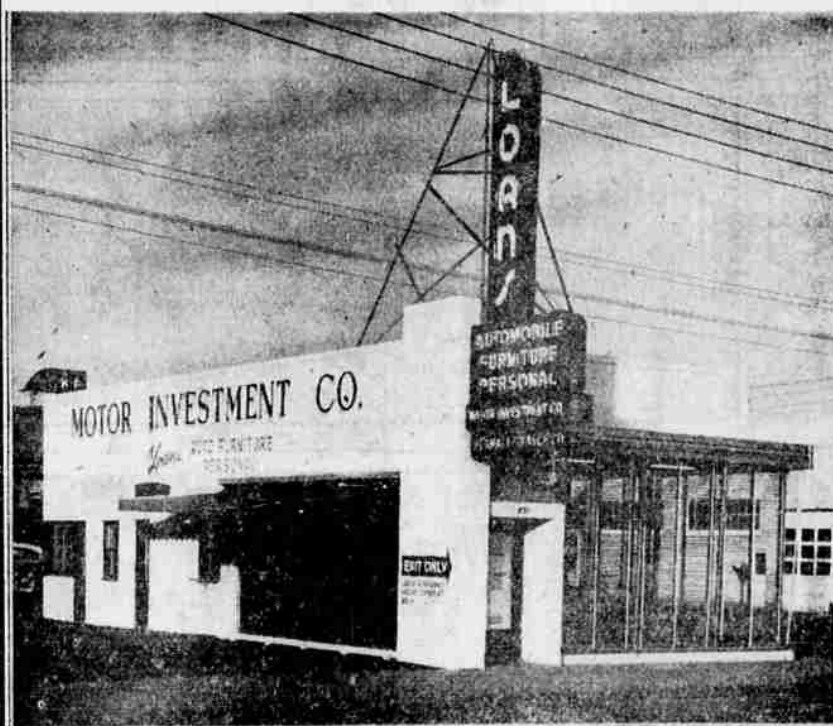
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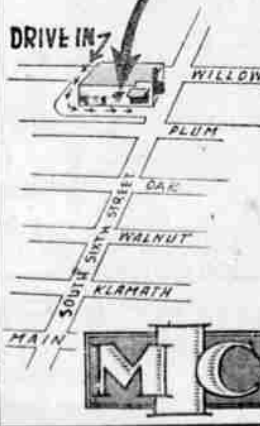
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
