

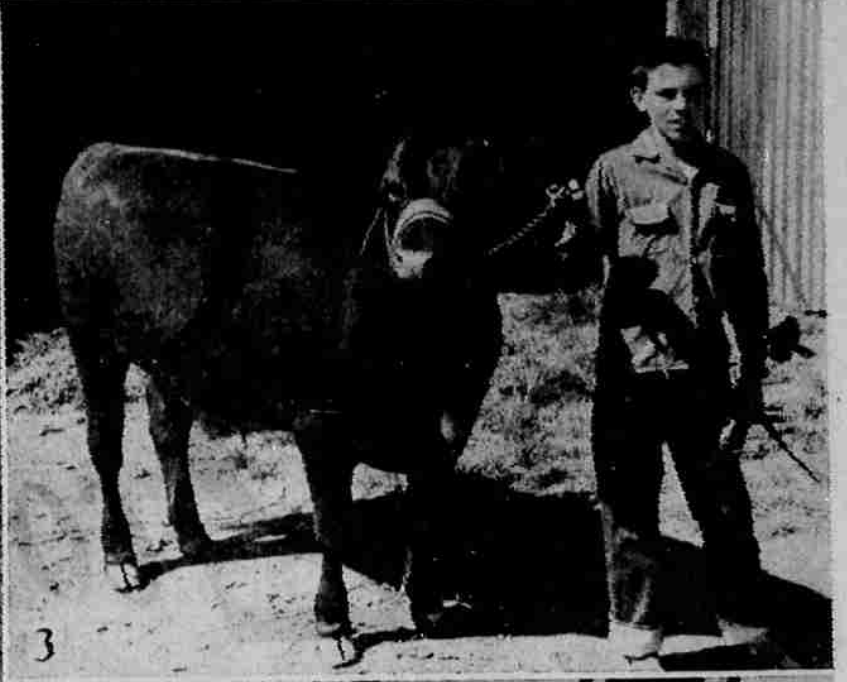
# Klamath County 4-H, FFA Members Ready Entries For Stock Show

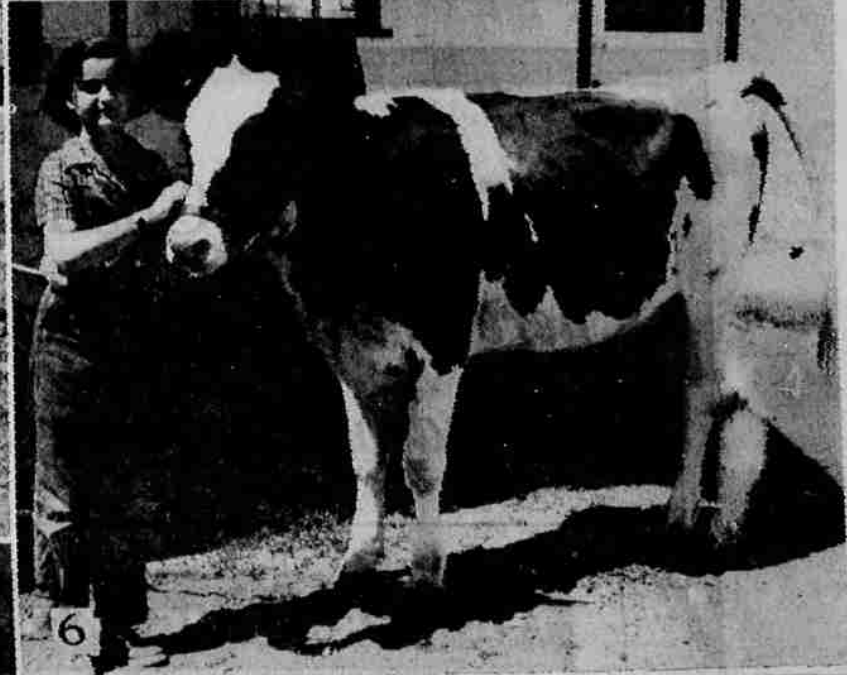

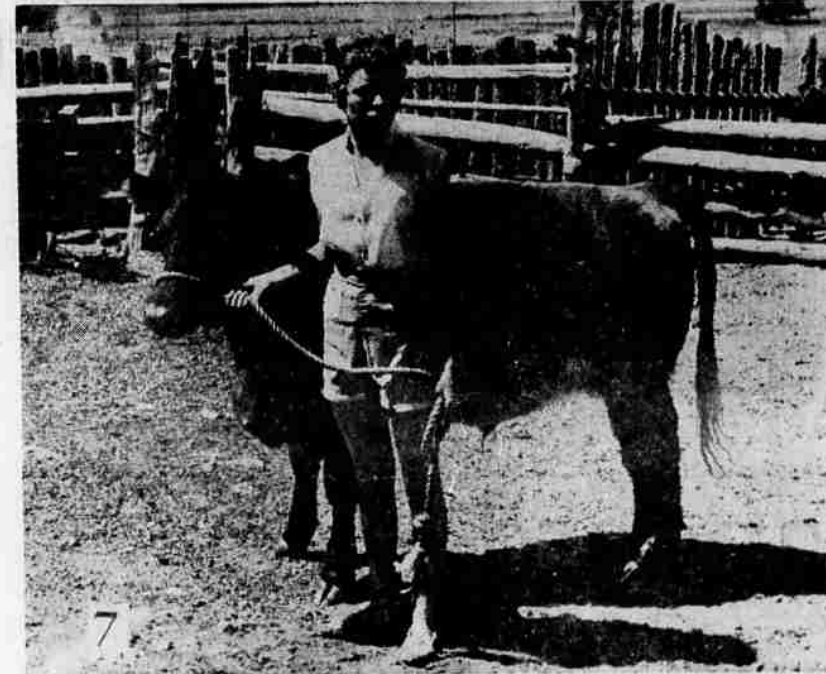

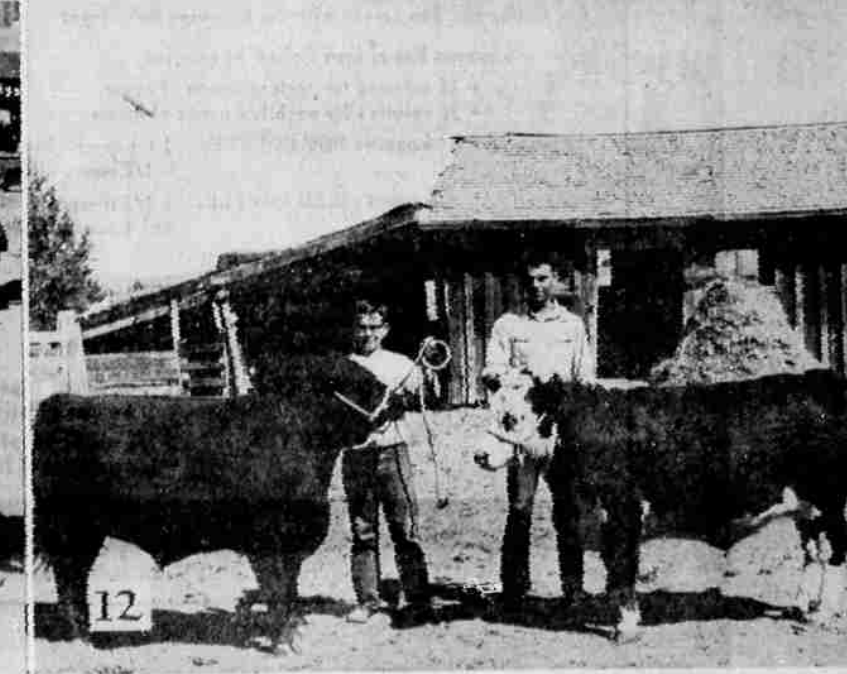
