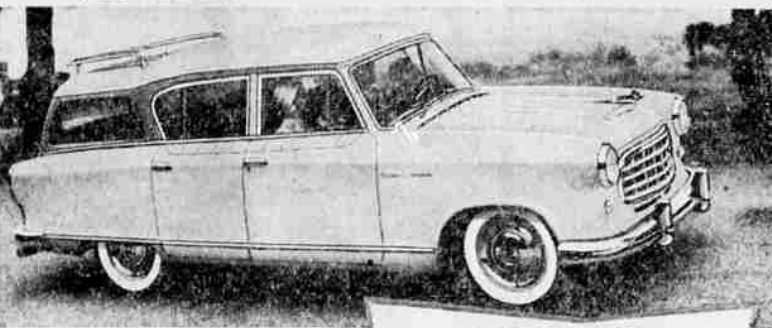
### Flower School Courses Offered

The Rev. Mr. and Mrs. Graef and their two sons will be in Klamath Falls until September 11, on which day he will preach his farewell sermon.

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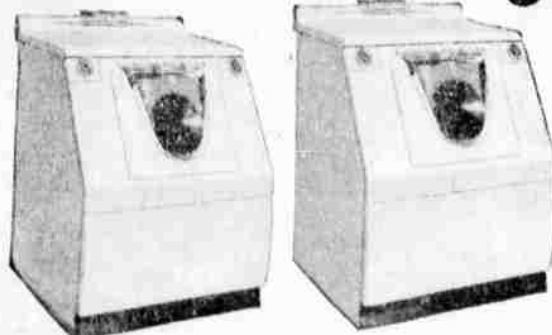
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
