Another Minister Faces Dismissal

MILWAUKEE — The second formal heresy trial in the 60-year history of the Northwest Synod of the United Lutheran Church began Tuesday, a month after the first such church trial ended in conviction of a young suburban minister.

Before the trial began in the Rev. John Gerberding, 33, of Menomonee Falls, who last month sat with the Rev. George Crist Jr., as the latter conducted his own defense.

Pastor Gerberding has revealed only one of the seven specific counts against him. That one alleges he denies the "divine authority of the Holy Scripture, contrary to the witness of the scripture to itself and contrary to the Lutheran confessions."

Dr. Paul E. Bishop of Minneapolis, synod president, will attend the trial as an observer, as he did in the case of Pastor Crist.
