Nixon Tells Views About '56 Election

DENVER (UP)—Vice President Richard M. Nixon foresees a 1956 presidential race between President Eisenhower and one of three Democratic candidates, Adlai E. Stevenson, Gov. Averell Harriman of New York, or Sen. Estes Kefauver of Tennessee.

Tragedy-Marred Fish Derby Ends

ASTORIA (AP)—The last of the tragedy-marred big-money fish derbies on the Oregon side of the Lower Columbia closed Monday with a 50 lb., 4 oz. salmon the biggest one landed.

The biggest fish was landed by Norman Myers of Portland, an entrant in the Warrenton derby. He took the \$1,000 first prize.

In the Astoria derby the winner was Jerry Nelson of Sunnyside, Wash., who took the \$1,000 prize with a 45 lb., 12 1/2 oz. salmon.

In the future, under a new law, top prizes will be limited to \$25.

Across the river, the Chinook, Wash., derby—where there is no law banning big prizes—was won by Virginia Morgan of Portland with a 47 lb., 4 1/2 oz. salmon. In addition to the \$1,000 top prize, she got \$100 for the winning woman entrant.

Nixon expressed his views on the national political situation at a press conference after a top secret national security meeting with President Eisenhower. But he emphasized he did not discuss politics with the President.

Most Republican leaders, he said, are confident the President will run again and are basing their campaign plans on that assumption.

EXPLOSION

ATHENS, Greece (AP)—A stick of dynamite exploded early Tuesday in the Turkish consulate at Salonika. No one was injured but windows in the consulate and in nearby houses were broken.

He predicted a "horse race" for the 1956 Democratic presidential nomination among Stevenson, the 1952 nominee, Harriman and Kefauver. He discounted the tendency of "professional politicians" to underestimate the "down to earth vote-getting ability" of Kefauver.

Nixon told reporters he "never saw the President look better" than he looked yesterday. "I feel he is in tiptop shape both physically and mentally," he added.

The vice president admitted that the GOP may be in serious political trouble in the farm belt because of falling crop prices.

But he said he is not as pessimistic about it as some people think the Republicans should be.

Nixon said the mushrooming growth of television as a blank medium for reaching millions of voters may mean drastic changes in national campaigning methods next year.

He said that may mean more TV appearances for the top candidate and less of the old-fashioned "whistle-stop" campaigning.

He flatly dismissed the controversy over Sen. Joseph R. McCarthy (R-Wis.) as a campaign issue in 1956 and predicted the GOP will win because it is "more unified than at any time since 1852" his own party.

Solon Scores FPC Chairman

WASHINGTON (UP)—Sen. Warren G. Magnuson said today the chairman of the Federal Power Commission should have disqualified himself from the decision to let a private utility develop power in Hells Canyon.

The Washington Democrat said Chairman Jerome Kuykendall should have done so because of his relationship with Gov. Arthur B. Langlie of Washington.

Langlie is an opponent of development of Hells Canyon power by the government and reportedly sponsored Kuykendall for the FPC post.

In an interview with Rural Electrification Magazine, Magnuson also said he believed the FPC membership was stacked against the Idaho Power Co. to develop the power resources of Hells Canyon along the Snake River on the Idaho-Oregon border. But public power advocates have asked the FPC to reconsider the decision. If the FPC decision stands, they have promised to appeal to the U.S. Court of Appeals.

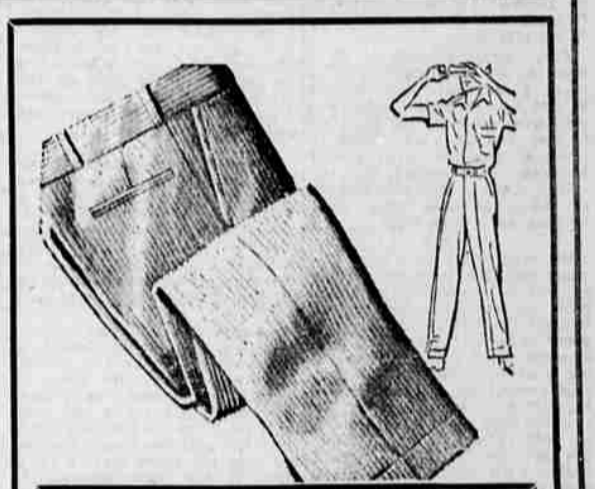
