### GOP Leader Sparks Drive To Force Ike's Candidature

WASHINGTON (AP)—Republican State Chairman Samuel L. Bodine of New Jersey spearheaded today a drive aimed at forcing an early announcement by President Eisenhower whether he will run again in 1960.

Bodine said in an interview he will ask GOP state chairman attending a campaign school here to organize formally and sign a petition asking the President to seek a second term. The New Jersey chairman predicted all would sign.

"I am recommending that the state chairmen organize independently of the party and take united action to make it clear to the President that the party needs him as a candidate," Bodine said. Eisenhower might thus be persuaded, he said, to announce his intentions "at once."

The 48 GOP state chairmen, attending a national committee school here on campaign tactics, will fly to Denver, Colo., at the conclusion of their classes for a Saturday morning breakfast with the President.

Murray Snyder, assistant White House press secretary, said in Denver the President will have no

Floyd S. Landreth of Virginia said it is "too early to tell" how that state will vote, but he believes Eisenhower support is "firmer than it was four years ago."

In addition, State Chairman John T. Diederich predicted that if the economic situation remains good "definitely, we will carry Kentucky."

Vice President Nixon scheduled two appearances before the group today.

Don Pierson, Iowa Republican chairman, said in a statement last night he has found that all of his colleagues agreed without exception that Eisenhower will be a candidate for re-election next year "and he will lead the Republican ticket to one of its greatest victories."

National Chairman Leonard W. Hall said in advance of the second day's sessions of the campaign school he believes his party will make new inroads into the South in congressional contests, as well as the presidential race.

"I have never seen so much enthusiasm among the Republicans in the South," Hall said. "The Republican organizations in Florida, Texas and North Carolina are going concerns."

Eisenhower carried Florida, Texas, Tennessee and Virginia in 1952. GOP state chairmen from three of those states said in separate interviews they hope for a repeat performance next year, Chairman
