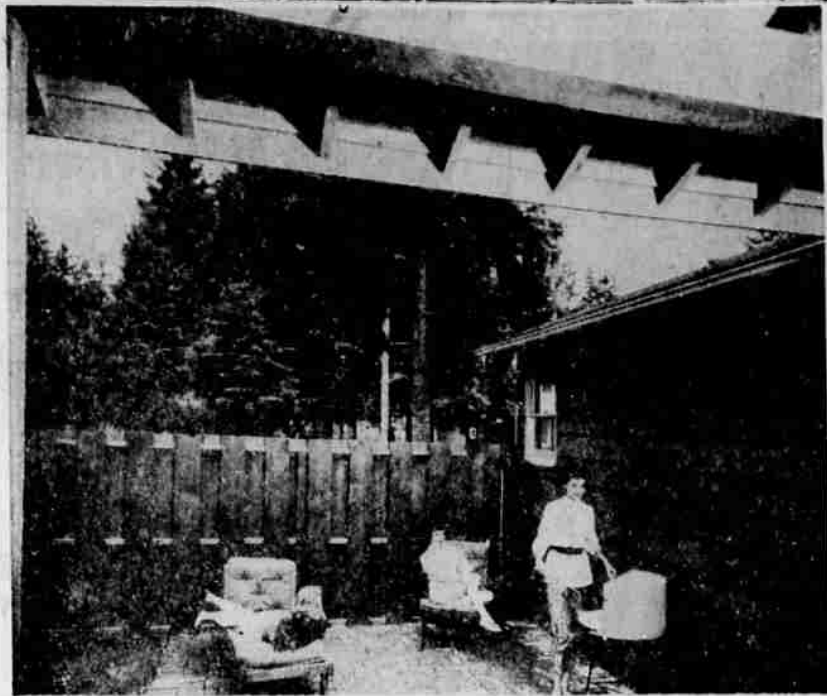




A LOW-COST PATIO can be yours without too much effort. An inexpensive fence has turned this waste yard space into a cozy patio for lounging, sunbathing and cooling at the portable barbecue. Made of rough-sawn western red cedar board to match the siding of the home, fence boards are alternated on each side of a frame to permit circulation of air into the play yard.

Budget Patio

You don't have to yearn for a patio any more. Now you can have one and it won't cost very much.

It can be spacious or cozy. The only limitation is the size of fence you decide to build. That's right. You can make a perfectly acceptable patio with a simple screening fence, built as an extension of the walls of the home.

If your home is sided in rough western red cedar, then you will want to build your fence of the same material. However, you can vary the style of the fence and it need not follow the siding pattern.

There are two things to remember in planning this budget patio. One is to plan your fence high enough to give full privacy and you will want to provide for free flow of cooling breezes.

Five feet or higher is recommended and this length of fence board can be cut economically from available lengths of either cedar or Douglas fir stocked by most retail lumber yards. To get cooling breezes, the fence can be built on the alternating board plan. This style is very simple. Nail every other board on the opposite side of the fence frame. This will give you good air space for circulation. The frame can be either 2x4 or 2x3 inch fir or cedar dimension firmly nailed to fence posts. It is well to have three rows of this dimension lumber to nail fence board on for this will give you a good solid fence which will last indefinitely.

The floor of the patio can carry out the budget theme and still give you a most attractive outdoor installation. If you use old brick, better make a footing of sand to set them in. It isn't necessary to use mortar unless you care to spend the extra money, because the bricks or stone will nestle down snugly and solid if properly set in sand.

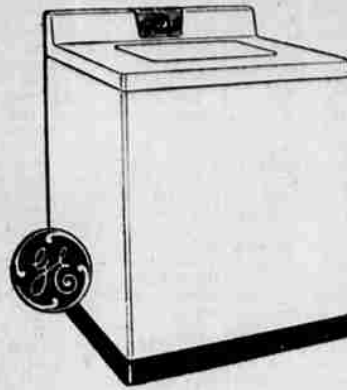
You can go a little bit richer in taste by building a wooden deck for your patio floor. This is one you can build yourself. Build a frame of 2x8 or 2x8 Douglas fir and set it up off the ground on small cement piers. Then lay the decking in fir 2x4s with each piece on edge and nail them so there is about a quarter inch space in between each 2x4 so that water will drain away. This makes a fine deck with Riviera class and the cost is low.

The floor and fence are minimum patio needs. You can add to these fundamentals as you get the

time to build seats, barbecue pit and fireplaces, tables and other permanent gear. You don't have to wait forever to enjoy the outdoors in your own patio. Portable barbecue stands and low cost lawn furniture puts you in business. Struts along the fence line, both inside and outside the patio help develop the rustic theme and blend the man-made installation with nature.

Green pears may be ripened at

home by keeping at room temperature of 60 to 70 degrees for several days until they respond to gentle pressure. Ripen them only as needed, however, as they do not "hold" once they are ripe enough to eat.

HOME HEATING

BATTER TOAST
