

Student Takes Honors Course

John Shaw, pre-med freshman at the University of Oregon and the son of Mr. and Mrs. Clyde E. Shaw, 338 Mortimer, has qualified for the new Sophomore Honors course. Shaw is a 1955 graduate of Klamath Union High School.

The university reports that the new course is a basic training in the main branches of liberal study. Its purpose is to provide profitable and stimulating general education, especially for the ablest students of the school. Only the students in the top 20 per cent of the entrance examination rolls are permitted to enroll.

The course is designed to lay a broad foundation for more advanced work in both liberal and professional fields, the university states. It fills that part of a student's schedule normally devoted to fulfillment of group requirements. The course is for the first two years in college and consists of 28 hours.

Honors are awarded at the end of the sophomore year—hence the name of the course. The awards are based on a series of exams in four liberal fields.

The school release states that most pre-med students usually substitute the honors course in physical science for regular introductory courses in physics and chemistry.

Shaw is a pledge at the Sigma Phi Epsilon fraternity.

President Plans New Appeal To Reds For Blueprint Swaps

WASHINGTON (UP)—President Eisenhower is making a new appeal to Russia to support his plan to swap military blueprints and arrange aerial survey flights over both countries, administration officials said today.

Officials said the new bid for Russian support is an important part of the President's "interim" reply to Premier Nikoia I. Bulganin's Sept. 19 letter on disarmament.

The reply to Bulganin was drafted in final form during Secretary of State John Foster Dulles' conference in a Denver hospital room Tuesday with the ill President.

Mr. Eisenhower also was expected to inform Bulganin that the United States still is working on a broader disarmament program.

It was learned that Dulles, before going to Denver, held a conference here Sunday with Harold E. Stassen, Mr. Eisenhower's special disarmament adviser. The recommended letter to Bulganin and Dulles' disarmament statements at the Miami American Legion convention on Monday were discussed by Dulles and Stassen, it was said.

Mr. Eisenhower's letter will be made public as soon as it is handed to Bulganin. It is expected to be conciliatory and indicate American willingness to accept some features of Russia's proposed arms inspection plan if the Reds will accept the President's offer on blueprints and "massive reconnaissance."

The President also was certain to emphasize that the blueprint-reconnaissance plan was not disarmament in itself — but an important step toward building confidence which could lead to disarmament. It has been tagged inside the administration as a "pre-disarmament plan."

Stricken Bonn Leader Improves

BONN, Germany (AP)—The West German government announced Wednesday that Chancellor Adenauer has shown "further improvement" in the last 24 hours of his battle with bronchial pneumonia.

Although the 73-year-old government chief's doctors said Tuesday they could not tell when he would resume his duties, the government said Wednesday it was hoped he could take part in a Cabinet meeting Oct. 21.

Driver Cleared Of Dean Death

PASO ROBLES, Calif. (AP)—A coroner's jury decided Tuesday that the fatal injury of James Dean, 24-year-old movie star, in a two-car collision Sept. 30 was "accidental death with no criminal negligence."

At the inquest, California Highway Patrolman O. Hunter testified Dean's sports car was traveling 85 miles an hour when he stopped him near Bakersfield the afternoon of the accident and gave him a speeding ticket.

Other witnesses said Dean was going 75 m.p.h. just before the fatal collision at the junction of Highways 41 and 466.
