### 4-H Members' Rolls Rise

Membership in 4-H clubs in Oregon has gone up almost five percent since last year, according to Hutton Hutton, state 4-H leader at Oregon State College. A 1954 member increase pushed enrollment figures up to 26,537 girls and boys in clubs throughout the state.

Girls led boys by four to one in the membership increase with 10,272 girls and 182 boys listed as first-year members. This makes a total of 16,691 girls and 9,846 boys in Oregon clubs.

Hutton said more and more members who have been in organization work for six years or longer are staying active. Older member interest was exhibited last summer by a 109 increase in the number of members 15 years or older who attended 4-H summer school at OSC.

### Lost Salem Hunters Found

DALLAS, Ore. (AP) — Two Salem hunters, newly exhausted after being lost overnight in the woods near here, were found by searchers at dusk Tuesday.

First clue to the missing men's whereabouts was provided by a woman motorist who said she had heard muffled shouts while driving the Falls City-Valdez highway late Tuesday afternoon.

The woman, whose name was not learned, said she had heard the shouts on the south side of the road. Until then searchers had been concentrating on the north side.

Jack Vann, a state forest department employe, took a crew into the area pointed out by the woman and the two men, Fred Gephart, 38, and his companion Bill Zuck, were found preparing to spend another night in the cold rain.

The two men, who became the subject of a widespread search when they failed to return Monday night from a hunting trip, told of wandering throughout the night without coats. Zuck had given his
