Lily Circle Plans Thanksgiving Sale

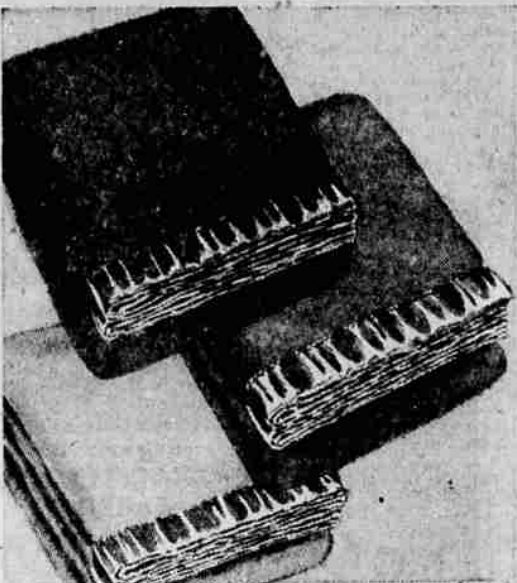
