WEED—Roundhouse steam engine facilities at Weed are being discontinued this week, it was announced today by Southern Pacific division officials at Dunsmuir.

Reason given is the "modernization" of the railroad industry and general dieselization of motive power.

In addition, the movement of logs by rail from the Tennant operation of the Long-Bell Lumber Company has been so curtailed that the need for car men at Weed has been drastically reduced.

One car man will remain in Weed. The other nine who have been employed here are being offered opportunities of employment elsewhere in the division, railroad officials stated.
