Four Motorists Killed In Crash

PENSACOLA, Fla. (AP)—Four persons were fatally injured in a traffic accident involving nine vehicles on heavily traveled U.S. Highway 90 about four miles west of Pensacola late Saturday night. Patrolman Fred Parish said a fast-moving automobile slammed into a line of cars halted for a truck making a left turn off the highway. James W. Brockway and Billy McKinney Cooper, both 25, of New Hope, Ala., died at the scene. Malcolm S. Best, 27, and James E. McCloskey, 26, both of Pensacola, died later of severe burns.

Russians Tour SF House Tract

SAN FRANCISCO (UP)—A group of Russian housing experts scheduled visits to mushrooming real estate tracts in the San Francisco Bay Area today. The Russians planned to tour the Midtown Terrace development in San Francisco, Rollingwood and Crestmoor in San Bruno, Millbrae Meadows on the Peninsula, and several other tracts in Alameda and Contra Costa counties.

The group arrived Saturday night from Seattle for a two-day tour of the Bay Area. I. K. Kozulla, heading the 10-man delegation, said he found little change in this country's housing industry in the 10 years since he was last here. The biggest change he said he discovered was the trend away from multiple dwellings in favor of single-story houses. He said he was most impressed by this country's "high speed elevators."

Washington State, 6. Oregon State, 7. Fresno State. Dairy goat judging: R. W. Casebeer, Portland, won four of eight possible awards. Wool fleece: Paul Spillman, Powell Butte, Ore., won grand prize. 4-H livestock judging: Grant County, Oregon. 4-H economics judging: Jackson County, Oregon. Dixie Wootton, Roseburg, was high individual in this event.

Solons Aid Egypt Fund

CAIRO, Egypt (AP)—Four U.S. senators dropped donations for Egypt's armament fund drive into a contribution box presented to them outside Premier Gamal Abdel Nasser's office Monday. Senators Harley M. Kilgore (D-W.Va.), John L. McClellan (D-Ark.), Leverett Saltonstall (R-Mass.), and John C. Stennis (D-Miss.) talked for an hour and a half with Nasser. They were accompanied to the interview by Ambassador Henry Byrnes.

Afterward they said only "we discussed Egyptian problems with the Premier" and "it was a good meeting." As they departed, a man in the corridor thrust a box at them and asked for contributions to the fund to pay for arms. Collections are being made throughout the country in an "armament week" campaign. Egypt has arranged to buy arms from Communist Czechoslovakia. The senators declined to say how much they gave. They arrived here Sunday on an official visit as members of the Senate Appropriations Committee studying the use of American aid in the Middle East. They leave Tuesday for Italy.

Four Killed In Accidents

FRESNO (UP)—Traffic accidents in the San Joaquin Valley during the weekend claimed the lives of at least four persons, the Highway Patrol reported today. Fourteen-month-old Carroll Brent Stalworth was killed Saturday night when he was run over in the driveway of a neighbor's home in South Stockton. The driver of the car, Frank R. Bailey of Stockton, told investigators he failed to see the child as he backed from the driveway. An unidentified man, about 65, was struck and killed by a car last night while attempting to cross Highway 99 about seven miles north of Merced. Mrs. Grace E. Germaine, 32, Corona, driver of the car, was not cited. James Morgan Early, 33, Bakersfield, died Saturday when his panel truck went out of control five miles southwest of Maricopa on Highway 166 and crashed into an embankment. Mrs. Leola Newton, 54, Oakland, was killed early today when a car in which she was riding swerved off Highway 99 about four miles north of Goshen.
