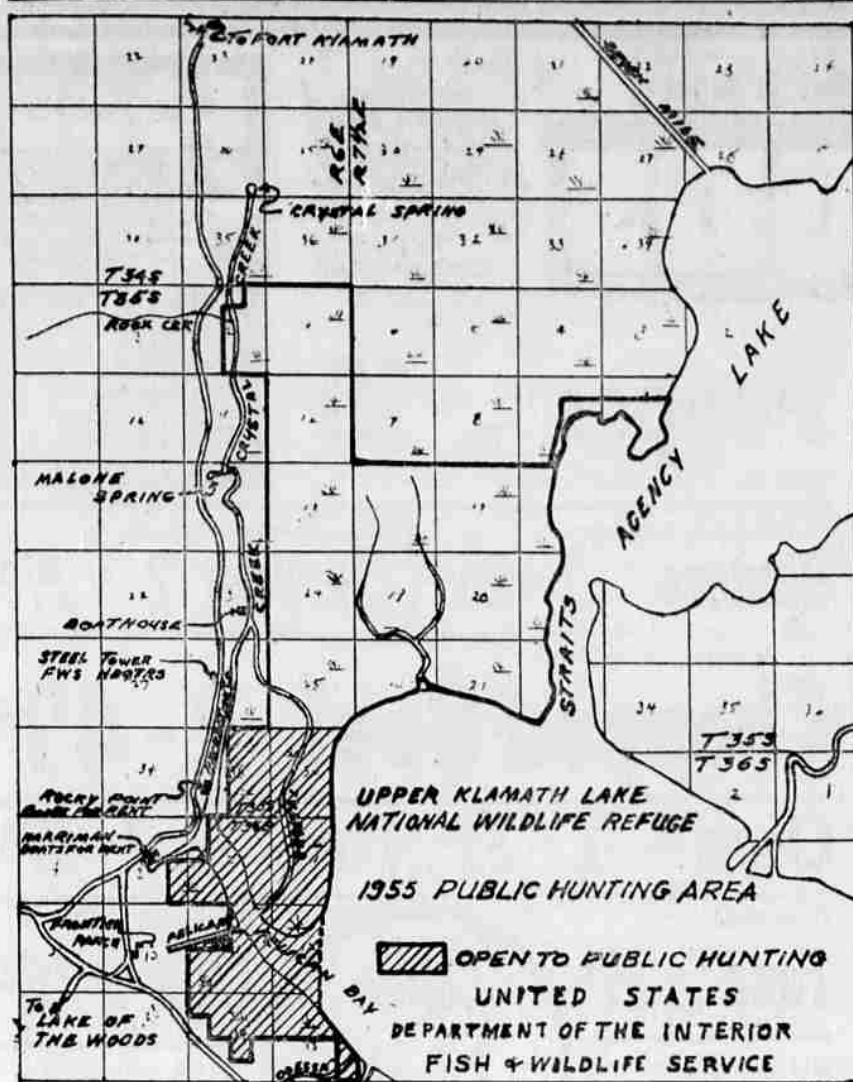




TO KLAMATH FALLS

APPROXIMATELY 2,500 ACRES on the Upper Klamath Lake Wildlife Refuge are being opened this year for the first time for public shooting of migratory waterfowl. The area is from Odessa to beyond the Rocky Point resort as indicated on the above map. Announcement of the opening of the public hunting grounds by the U.S. Department of the Interior, Fish and Wildlife Service, was made by Tom Horn, Tulare Lake Refuge manager. Hunters are requested to clip the map for reference. Ducks, geese and coots may be shot during the 1955 waterfowl hunting season on areas posted for hunting. Persons on the refuge must comply with the hunting laws of the state of Oregon and the federal laws. Each person hunting may take dogs, not to exceed two per person on the public shooting grounds for the purpose of retrieving dead or wounded birds. Such dogs must not run at large on the grounds or elsewhere on the refuge. Persons entering the refuge shall follow routes of travel designated by the officer in charge.

Paddy Flunks; Gets Cadillac

NEW YORK (AP)—Baseball whiz Patrick (Paddy) Keough of St. Louis struck out last night on the \$32,000 question.

He was given a \$5,000 Cadillac as a consolation prize on the CBS television and radio giveaway show "The \$64,000 Question."

Keough, a 62-year-old businessman, is the first loser at a prize level above \$3,000 in the 20 weeks the show has been on the air.

He was asked what baseball player holds the record batting

average for three different major league teams, the names of the teams and the player's record average with each.

Keough identified Rogers Hornsby as the player and the St. Louis Cardinals, Chicago Cubs and Boston Braves as the teams.

Two other contestants made the grade on the \$16,000 question.

Don E. Self Jr., 24-year-old

physicist from El Paso, Tex., in his mythology category.

The Rev. Alvin B. Kershaw, rector of the Holy Trinity Episcopal Church in Oxford, Ohio, made the grade in his jazz category.

Self and the Rev. Mr. Kershaw will announce on the program next Tuesday night whether they will try then for the \$32,000 question.

Battle Wagon Goes Aground

NEW YORK (AP)—The huge battleship Wisconsin was stranded on a reef in New York harbor for nearly an hour yesterday. A strong tide pushed her aground while she was being towed to the Brooklyn Navy Yard.

A fleet of 16 tugs pulled the 45,000-ton vessel off the mud bank at the mouth of the East River, some 500 feet off the tip of Manhattan.

The Navy said the ship, which is 885 feet long, apparently suffered no harm. A spokesman said the Wisconsin was under control of a civilian pilot and being towed by civilian tugs.

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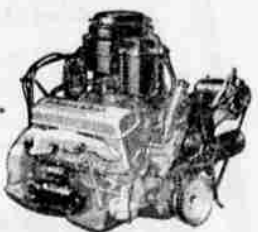

Youth Charged For Slaying

PASADENA, Calif. (AP)—A youth apparently recovering from injuries suffered, police said, when he threw himself under a truck has been formally charged with murdering his mother.

The complaint was issued against John P. Hawley, 19. He is accused of killing Mrs. Iris Hawley, 45, with a hammer in her fashionable home early Sunday.

Police said that after the killing, young Hawley drove the family automobile to Cajon Pass near San Bernardino and attempted to end his life. He suffered critical injuries when run over by the truck.

Hospital authorities say it will be a week or 10 days before the youth can be transferred to the prison ward of the Los Angeles County Jail. He underwent eight hours of surgery Monday.

Detective A. Leonard of San Bernardino, who said the Hawley youth has a history as a mental patient, reported the youth told him, "I did it. I killed my mother."

Pasadena Detective Richard L. Jamison said Hawley told him of an argument with his mother Sunday after they had taken his father William Hawley to the airport for a flight to San Francisco.

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
