

Man Charged With Murder

TOWSON, Md. (AP)—An auto plant worker was charged with murder today and an Army sergeant and a waitress were accused of being accessories in the slaying of John I. Adams, key figure in a six-million-dollar numbers raid.

Baltimore County police said the 39-year-old victim was strangled for his money and that the murder weapon apparently was a "woman's stocking."

They said they had located the \$1,000 Adams reportedly was carrying when he disappeared a week ago last night.

Police Chief Hamilton R. Atkinson said Pedro Finley Grooms, 23-year-old auto plant worker, was charged with the murder.

Atkinson said Helen Jefferson, 30, and Sgt. Robert Palmer, stationed at Ft. Holabird, were charged with "being accessories after the fact to murder."

Palmer was identified as a former UCLA premedical student who has a wife and children in Texas.

The defendants and the victim are Negroes.

Adams was one of six arrested Sept. 28 when state police raided an establishment at Turner Station, U.S. 40 on the eastern outskirts of Baltimore.

His hands were tied, his head had been bashed in and he had been garroted.

French Press Saarlanders

SAARBRUECKEN, Saar (AP)—Saarlanders were under new pressure today to accept the German governments today to put themselves under European authority in voting this weekend.

The million people of this rich coal and steel valley today Sunday in a yes-or-no plebiscite on the French-German accord of October 1954, intended to settle the bitter contentions over the border territory's future.

The compact, part of the bargain for German rearmament in NATO, provides for the Saar (1) a firm economic and customs union with France; (2) later, self-government; and (3) supervision of its foreign relations by a high commissioner appointed by the rearmament Western European Union.

Pro-German parties in the German-speaking valley have campaigned bitterly against the proposed Europeanization statute. They want to return to the German fatherland. Once before, when Hitler was in power in Germany, 90 per cent of the Saar's voters decided in a plebiscite in 1935 to cast off the League of Nations trusteeship and go back to Germany.

West German Chancellor Konrad Adenauer last night again urged the Saarlanders to vote yes next Sunday. Adenauer views the Saar agreement as a piece in his policy of settling old scores with France for the sake of West European unity and defense.

Driver Stays In Careening Truck

KITTANNING, Pa. (AP)—Truck driver Charles Deffrain—plucky, lucky and scared—stayed with his runaway rig as it careened down a steep hill, injuring three persons before crashing to a halt.

The brakes on the steel-laden truck gave way about one third of the way down Route 422 yesterday. The 42-year-old Williamsport, Pa., driver told police later, "All I did was push on the brake, blow the horn and pray."

Making a nearly 90-degree turn at the foot of the hill, the speeding truck sideswiped 10 autos before it stopped on a main street of this western Pennsylvania town.

Leaking gasoline ignited, but firemen quickly put out the blaze in the truck and the last car it hit. Deffrain was not injured. No charges were filed.
