

Fir Plywood Jubilee In Klamath October 25

KALPINE PLYWOOD INC., Klamath Falls only plywood mill, will be spotlighted during the Fir Plywood Jubilee to be held here Tuesday, October 25. The Klamath mill produces about 48 million board feet of plywood a year and employs 240 workers with a payroll of approximately \$1,320,000 per year. The mill has operated since 1938 and is owned by Plywood Inc., a Trenton, New Jersey firm. Harold J. Atkinson is the manager of the Klamath Falls plant. The firm will hold open house on the Jubilee day, October 25, from 1 to 4 p.m. Free coffee and doughnuts will be served. The jubilee exhibit, which shows the history of the industry, the many uses of the product, and many other interesting facts about it, will be displayed at the county fairgrounds exhibit building on Tuesday from 2 p.m. to 9 p.m. Carol Christensen, Seattle Sea Fair Queen, who travels with the show, is shown at lower left "taming" the fir plywood menagerie, a part of the exhibition.
