Boyd's Coffee Now Available In Klamath

Boyd's coffee, long a favorite with coffee drinkers in Pacific Northwest hotels, coffee shops and restaurants, is now for sale on your grocer's shelves.

People of the Pacific Coast have known Boyd's coffee since 1900. The coffee was first delivered in P. R. Boyd wagons, painted red, and drawn by well matched teams of horses. By 1907, the red wagons were serving most of the major cities on this coast.

Today, restaurants in eight Western states serve Boyd's coffee and now, for the first time, Boyd's coffee is packaged for the home-maker to buy at her favorite supermarket and grocery store. The move into the retail field is the result of long planning by the Boyd firm. After surveys were made throughout the West, it was determined that the homemaker wanted Boyd's coffee, too, and so now we have it.

Cotton Queen

The best cotton bag sewing from 37 states will be placed in competition on November 10 to decide the identity of the 1955 National Cotton Bag Sewing Queen.

Winning entries from 53 of the country's leading fairs will be displayed at the Morrison Hotel in Chicago, during judging finals in the third annual contest sponsored by the National Cotton Council and the Textile Bag Manufacturers Association.

Prizes for Finalists: Finalists named as "queen" and two runners-up will be awarded expense paid trips for themselves and escorts, a week of entertainment in Chicago, and valuable merchandise gifts. They will be recognized in special ceremonies scheduled for November 15 at the Morrison Hotel and will make guest appearances on network radio and television programs.

The display of clothing and household accessories made from cotton bags is expected to be the largest exhibit of its kind in packaging history, according to a Cotton Council spokesman. Articles made from the former containers of feed, flour, fertilizer, sugar, meal, salt, and other products will include dresses, sport shirts, pajamas, table linens, curtains, quilts, blouses, and stuffed toys.

Judges Named
The panel of prominent women judges to select the national winners will include Betty Pisk, fashion editor of Successful Farming; Frances Henry, clothing editor of What's New in Home Economics; Mabel Obenchain, mid-west manager of Famous Features; Mercedes Hurst, home economist of International Harvester Co.; and Martha Crane, Women's Director of Station WLS, Prairie Farmer Station, Chicago.

As fair winners, the contestants received cash prizes and Pfaff deluxe portable sewing machines. National awards include a wardrobe of cotton bag fashions, refrigerator, gas range, television set, radio, sewing cabinets, automatic washer, electric cotton sheets, and other household items.

COPPER PANS

Plentiful Pork

Now's the time to serve hearty dinner dishes to your family. With all the activities of the autumn season, the family's appetites often seem to reach the ravenous stage when meal time rolls around.

Pork steaks with browned rice is a hearty main dish—ideal for satisfying fall appetites. Browned rice is combined with seasonings to give good Spanish-rice-type flavor. Pork steaks, an economical meat selection right now, cook tender on top of the rice. Here's the recipe:

PORK STEAKS

- 4 pork shoulder steaks
- 2 tablespoons fat
- 1 cup uncooked rice
- 1 No. 303 can tomatoes
- 1 1/2 cups water
- 1 cup finely chopped green pepper
- 1/2 cup finely chopped onion
- 3 tablespoons salt
- 1 teaspoon pepper

Brown shoulder steaks thoroughly in hot fat in a heavy skillet. Remove steaks and season to taste with salt. Sauté washed and drained rice in remaining fat about 5 min-

utes or until delicately browned, stirring constantly. Add water, vegetables and seasonings; blend well. Place steaks on top, cover and cook over low heat 35 to 40 minutes or until meat is tender and liquid has been almost entirely absorbed by the rice. Four servings.

A good fall menu including this pork steak dish might be: apple juice cocktail, pork steaks with browned rice, tossed salad, hard rolls and pumpkin tarts with whipped cream.

TENDERLOIN DELUXE

Here's an attractive and flavorful pork tenderloin serving. Cross two slices of bacon and place a pork tenderloin patty on the center. Season. Then place 1/2-inch thick slice of tomato on the patty, season and top with a 1/4-inch thick slice of onion. Bring bacon ends up over onion, and fasten with a wooden pick. Place in a baking dish; cover and bake for 30 minutes at 350 degrees. Remove cover and continue baking for 30 minutes longer.

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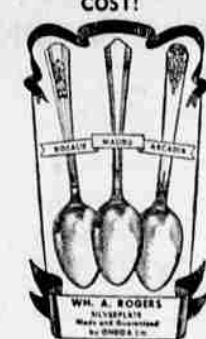
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
