

Circuit Court Upholds Award

SAN FRANCISCO (AP)—The Ninth U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals has upheld a \$201,274 damage award to the Hawaiian Pineapple Co. as a result of strike violence at The Dalles, Ore., in 1949.

The company brought the suit after a demonstration by the International Longshoremen's and Warehousemen's Union halted unloading of a barge-load of canned pineapple shipped from Honolulu while the port was closed by a strike of Hawaii ILWU members.

A Federal Court jury awarded \$201,274 in damages but specified the award should be paid by the ILWU and its Portland Local 8 and individual union members could not be held liable.

The decision added that "as a practical matter it does seem a little difficult to understand why the jury was, as the union attorneys claim, logically inconsistent."

But "that is a jury's prerogative," the court said.

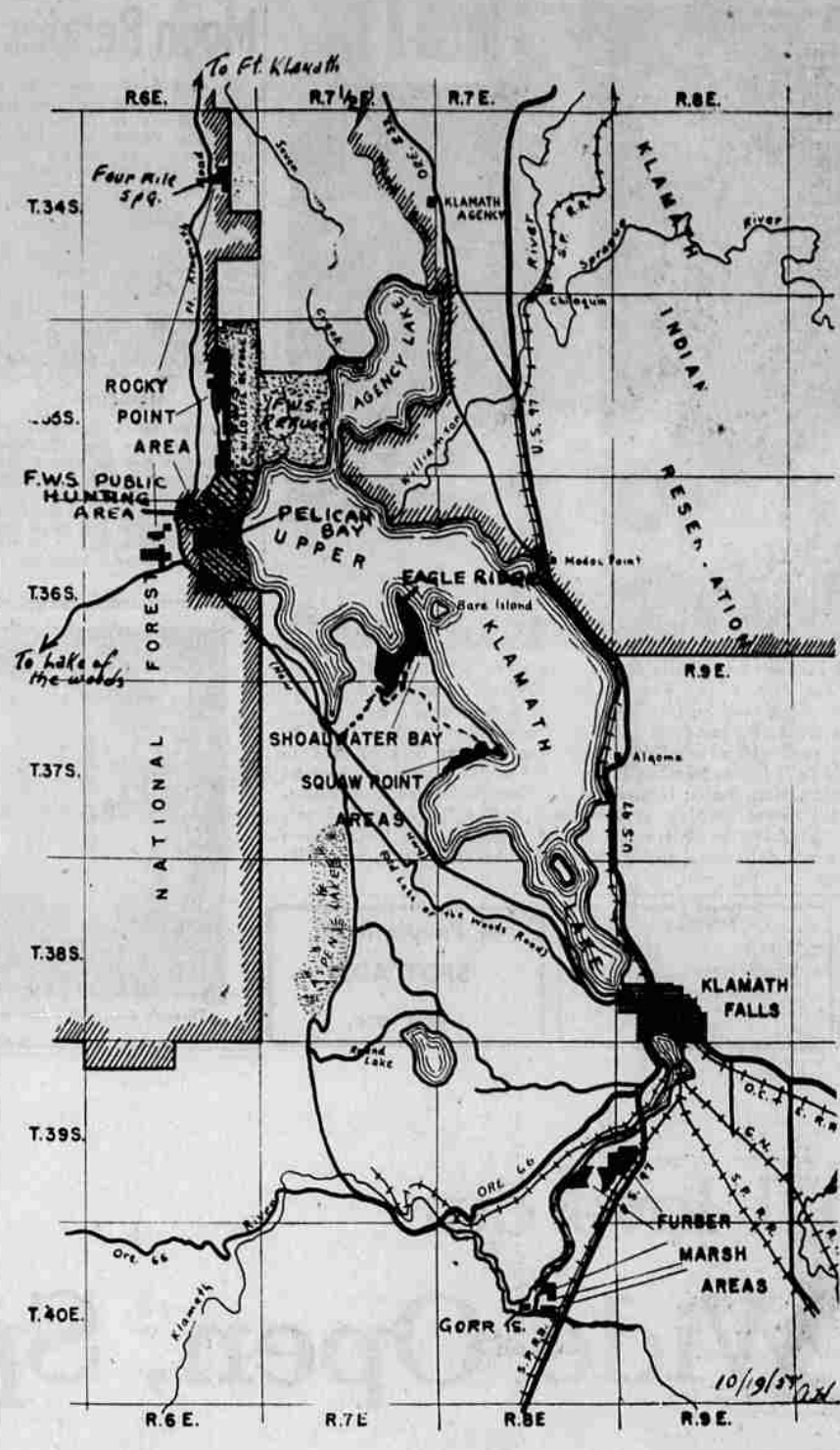
AIR BOOZE

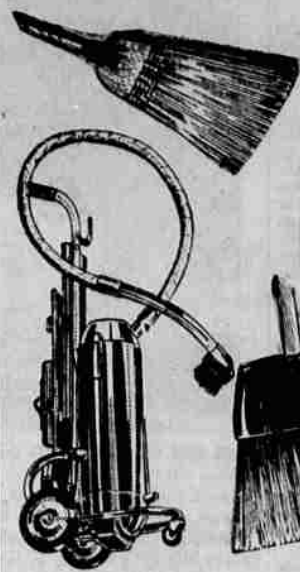

STATE GAME WATERFOWL HUNTING AREAS are shown in this map submitted to the Herald and News by Al Hoffmeister, state game commission employe. The state game areas, shown in black, include Gorr Island and Furber Marsh on the Klamath River south of Klamath Falls; Shoalwater Bay, Squaw Point, Eagle Ridge and Rocky Point areas on Upper Klamath Lake. Hoffmeister pointed out that these are all free hunting grounds open to anyone with the proper game licenses. Hoffmeister was formerly at the Sauvies Island game area near Portland. He is assisted with his duties at Klamath Falls by W. Hubbard. The game commission farms 406 acres of barley, oats, wheat and rye on their state owned lands on the Klamath River. The grain is left standing to provide feed for waterfowl and the land is flooded in the fall by pumping water from the river with a new portable pump purchased this fall in Klamath Falls.

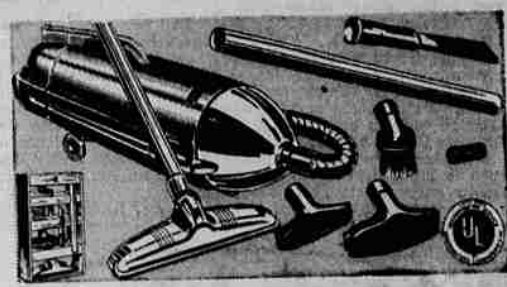
