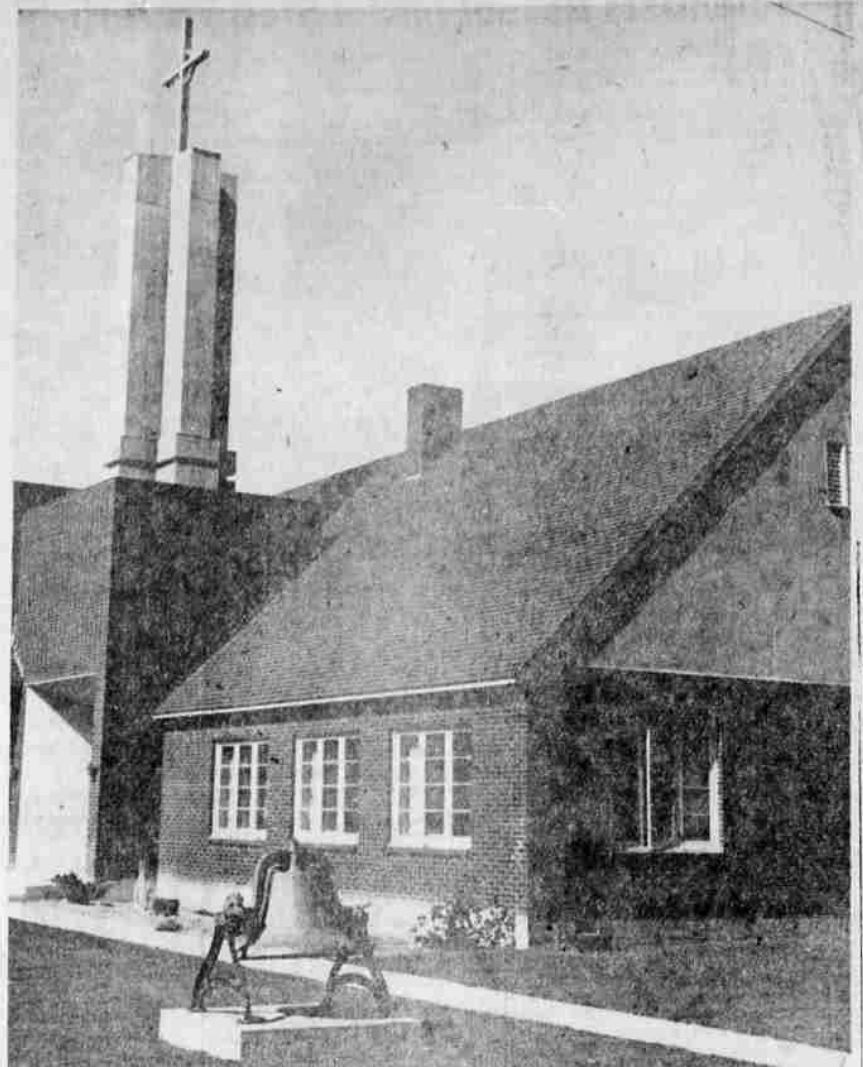

Merrill's First Presbyterian Church To Celebrate Anniversary Sunday

The 50th anniversary of the organization of the First Presbyterian Church in Merrill will be observed with a special service at 11 a.m. on Sunday, October 30 in the church sanctuary.

The present imposing brick structure replaces the first small frame building that was used by the congregation for many years. This building and its additions were destroyed by fire in December, 1948.

The church has an interesting history of its growth. The early days of worship in the Merrill community were recalled this week by Mrs. George Offield, one of the two living charter members of the church. Mrs. Offield still lives in Merrill. Mrs. Laura Hill, Lonsview, Washington, is the second living charter member.

Before the turn of the century, the early settlers of the small community at Merrill heard the Scriptures from Sunday School missionaries who rode through the country on horseback or arrived by horse and buggy. They made the Offield home their headquarters.

The Rev. W. G. Smith, pastor of the First Presbyterian Church, Klamath Falls also conducted services at Merrill.

In 1901, Mrs. S. E. Martin, now living in Piedmont, California, organized the Sunday School.

The first church gatherings were in private homes, in a small school building located on the present playground at the Merrill Recreation Hall and later in one room of the brick elementary building that burned a few years ago.

Mrs. Melissa Irven played the organ. Mrs. Jane Mason later kept the Sunday School group together until it was decided that the congregation was large enough to build a church in Merrill.

There were Methodists, Christians, Baptists, Presbyterians and members of other faiths in that first congregation.

The Rev. J. M. Ferguson came from Arizona and spent a year in Merrill to help organize the church. The first congregation had 12 members.

Before the church building could be completed, the Rev. Ferguson was replaced by the Rev. Robert Tweed, a bustling Scot.

When it came time to dedicate the building, \$6 remained to be

raised to dedicate the building debt-free. A number of a Christian Science Church, whose identity is unknown, passed his hat and the needed cash, plus a little more, was contributed. The church was completed at a cost of \$2,100 and the dedicatory service was held October 29, 1908.

The Merrill church, oldest in the southern part of the Klamath Basin, one-time center of the Lost River parish, became the mother church of churches later built at Malin and at Tulelake.

For 16 months after the original building was destroyed by fire, the congregation worshipped in the Merrill Recreation Hall. Members planned a new building and the present church was dedicated September 29, 1950. The old church bell was given to the church by the late Mr. and Mrs. Nathan Merrill. The Merrills also donated the land where the present church stands.

The anniversary sermon will be brought by the Rev. Forrest C. Travaile, ontime pastor of the church, now a missionary in Thailand. He is home on furlough and made a special visit to Merrill for the anniversary service.

At 7:30 p.m. he will give an illustrated lecture on Thailand to which the public is invited. Monday night, October 31, he will be guest of honor at a 6:30 p.m. potluck dinner in the social hall of the church.

The Rev. Travaile is the director of a cooperative farm at Chenoara, a unique experiment in rural Christian work. Unused land obtained from the government is being farmed by 50 selected Christian families with marked success.

Funds for the machinery and other necessary equipment have been borrowed, but it is hoped that within five years all debts will be paid off.

Under the leadership of Mr. Travaile, modern farming methods and better animal stock are bringing increased production and better incomes for the families who share in the experiment.

He first went to Thailand in 1938 and began his missionary work as an evangelist. His farm program was inaugurated soon after the end of World War II following special training in this country.

He will be the guest of Mr. and Mrs. M. A. Bowman during his stay in Merrill.


