Defense Vital To Spartans

CHICAGO (UP)—Defense paid off for Michigan State as much as long runs in its 27-0 win over Wisconsin, Badger Coach by Williamson contended to the coaches' "walling wall" today.

"They were too much for us," he said, "It wasn't only their offense that hurt us. They killed us with their defense, just swarming over our ball carriers."

The Spartans' Duffy Daugherty paid tribute to sophomore halfback Wall Kowalczyk, who gained 172 yards in 19 carries. "He's the fastest man on our team, and he got that long run, one of the most beautiful I've ever seen. He got a couple of blocks at the line and then just outran their secondary. He had to straight arm one man, but he ran away from the rest of them. It was on the belly series, and (Earl) Morrill did a very fine job of faking to the fullback and a decoy and giving the ball to the trailing halfback."

Bennie Oosterbaan of Michigan described the 33-point second half comeback of his team against Iowa as the "greatest game I've ever seen Michigan play. I imagine television watchers saw one of their greatest shows of the year."

"They outgassed us for the ball and then ran away from us," Iowa's Forest Evashevski said. "I thought we had them. We were leading, 21-17, and went in and scored again. But it was called back then (Ron) Kramer made a couple of phenomenal catches and we were done."

Purdue's Stu Holcomb said that his team fought against Illinois that a good rain on first down made the road easier. "Instead of ending up with second and nine, we had second and two or three. We were able to move the ball well, and we only had to throw a couple of times. It was our best game."

Ray Elliot of Illinois rated the Boilermakers as "too powerful for us. They knocked the hell out of us. We couldn't get the ball and when we did, we didn't get a decent chance to throw it. They could move pretty well for big fellows."

Passing killed Northwestern, Ohio State's Woody Hayes said, because "those interceptions cost them 40 yards each. We were able to run every play, and we ran with consistency. We even tried to get back early at the half to watch our band."

Lou Saban of Northwestern said that Ohio State "had too many guns. I believe it was their best game. They were like crazy. They hit harder and ran harder, and that (Howard) Cassidy is a great inspirational leader."

Southern California had to overcome three handicaps against Minnesota, Murray Warmath said, and it was too much. "We had all the psychological advantages," he said. "We were underdogs, they were away from home, and we had inclement weather. We liked it and they didn't. It was that simple. We had men in good position, but I guess they just let up."

CORVALLIS, Ore., (UP)—Coach Tommy Prothro looked to his reserves today for another fullback to spell second-string Tom Berry in the Oregon State College lineup.

Regular tailback Joe Francis and reserve back Arlo Weststrand were both sidelined with injuries, leaving Berry the only player to fill the spot.

Prothro said Berry, who scored both Berry touchdowns in Saturday's 13-7 victory over Washington, "had quite an afternoon."

EUGENE, Ore., (UP)—Coach Len Casanova said today his University of Oregon Webfoots turned in a "pretty sloppy performance" despite their 25-0 win over Idaho.

The coach singled out only end Phil McHugh and sophomore Norm Chapman and Jack Brown for praise and added he was not too pleased with the rest of the squad.

BERKELEY, Calif., (UP)—Four California Bears were sidelined with injuries today and only one was expected to be ready for the Washington game Saturday.

Dick King, who started at tackle in the UCLA game but was taken out with a stretched muscle, was expected to return to the field this week.

Cherberg Hung On WCampus

It was still open season on Pacific Coast Conference football coaches Monday with Washington's Johnny Cherberg the latest target of the sideline quarterbacks.

Cherberg, whose Huskies lost 13-7 to Oregon State last Saturday, was hanged in effigy on the Washington campus. A sign pinned to the dummy read: "Goodbye, Johnny." The first students arriving on the campus tore down the dummy and ripped up the card.

Cherberg declined comment. University authorities said the effigy probably was the work of a prankster.

Cherberg was the second PCC coach hanged in effigy in recent weeks.

Lynn (Pappy) Waldorf, whose California Golden Bears play Washington at Berkeley this Saturday, suffered the same fate after his team lost to Oregon.

Other coaches also had their problems.

Idaho's Skip Stahley learned a first string guard, injured against Oregon last week, will have to quit football, and Southern California's Jess Hill had to explain to California sportswriters the Trojans' loss to Minnesota.

Eivend Resa, Idaho guard from Twin Falls, checked in on the Idaho campus after leaving a Eugene hospital and told Stahley he is giving up the game. Resa suffered a concussion in the Oregon game. Further medical tests were planned Tuesday.

Idaho players Oregon State next Saturday, Stahley said he would name starters for the contest after he has studied the Oregon moves.

Coach Jess Hill, talking to the Southern California football writers at Los Angeles, said the Minnesota line had done a fine job on the USC ends in the game's 25-19 upset victory in Burlington, N.C.

Hill noted that the backs in USC's secondary had to make more than twice as many tackles against Minnesota as against California.

California's Lynn Waldorf, playing Washington at Berkeley Saturday, was asked to compare the USC and UCLA squads after a 45-0 beating by the Bruins and a 33-6 pasting by the Trojans.
