

'Voice Of Democracy' Title To Be Sought By Students

November 15 has been picked as the date for the county finals in the Voice of Democracy contest, now under way in the schools of Klamath County, announced Jack Otterbein, contest chairman for the Klamath County Chamber of Commerce which is sponsoring the contest.

"All the schools of Klamath County are cooperating in the contest," said Otterbein, "but the Jaycees would like to encourage all high school students to participate in the contest."

Voice of Democracy is script writing and voicing competition which gives high school students an opportunity to speak for democracy. The Klamath County winner will be picked from among the nine high schools of the county after the November 15 broadcast over a local radio station — time to be announced later.

The winner in the county will compete with the winners from the other counties of the state for the state title. The county winners will have their presentations tape recorded for judging at the state contest. The state winner will receive a television set as the prize. Contestants prepare, preferably as classroom assignments, five minute scripts on the subject, "I Speak for Democracy."

The coded transcriptions of state and territorial winners are then sent to National VOD Committee Headquarters, where a screening committee composed of educators and representatives of the three sponsoring organizations will select 12 semi-finalists. Out of these 12 a panel of nationally-known citizens will choose the final four co-equal national winners.

The contest is sponsored by the National Association of Radio and Television Broadcasters, Radio-Electronics-Television Manufacturers Association and the U.S. Junior Chamber of Commerce. It is endorsed by the U.S. Office of Education and approved by the National Association of Secondary School Principals.

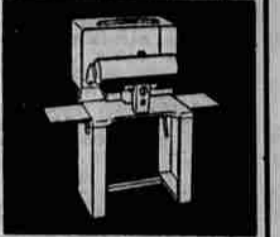

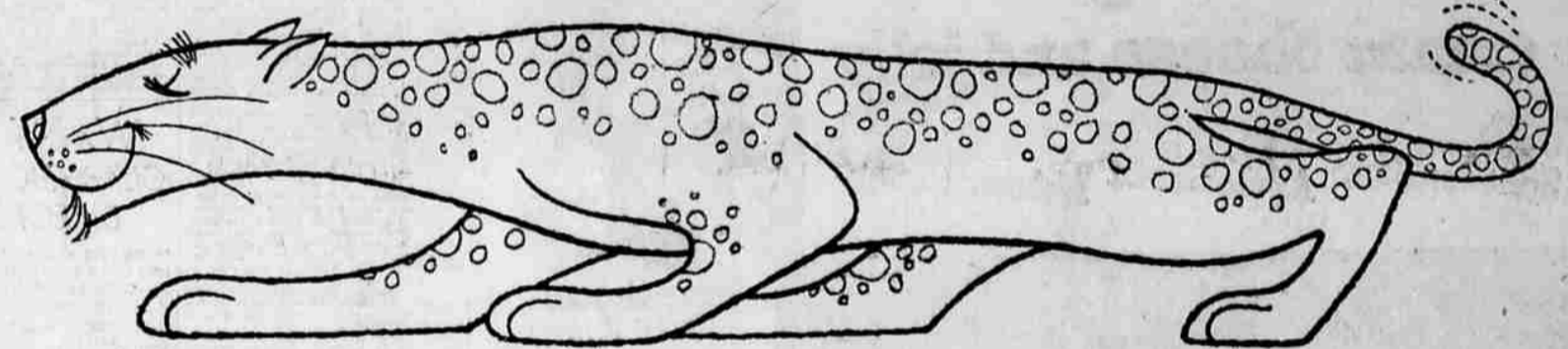

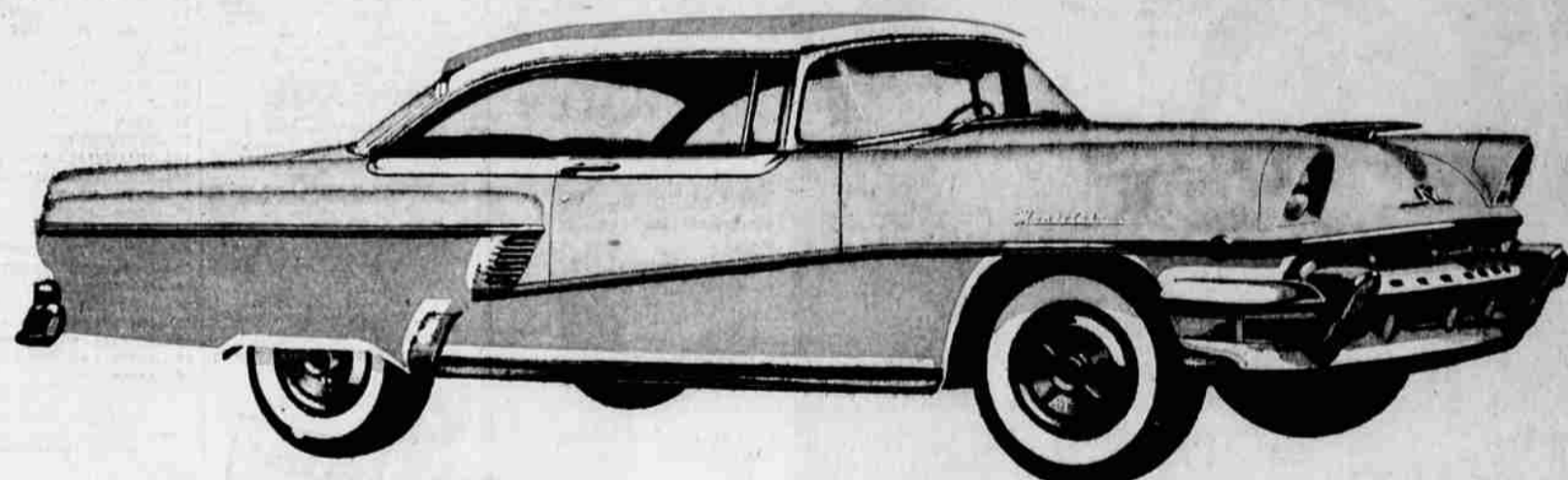
