

Humphrey Claims Stevenson Support By Favorite Sons

WASHINGTON (UP) — Sen. Hubert H. Humphrey (D-Minn.) said today he expects most of the "favorite son" candidates for the Democratic presidential nomination to throw their support eventually to Adlai E. Stevenson.

Stevenson, the 1952 nominee who lost to President Eisenhower, is expected to announce his candidacy for the 1956 nomination from Chicago next week.

"I think a majority of the favorite sons will be for Stevenson when all is said and done," said Humphrey, who already has declared for the former Illinois governor.

"In my opinion, Stevenson is way out in front and I would expect him to increase his commanding lead."

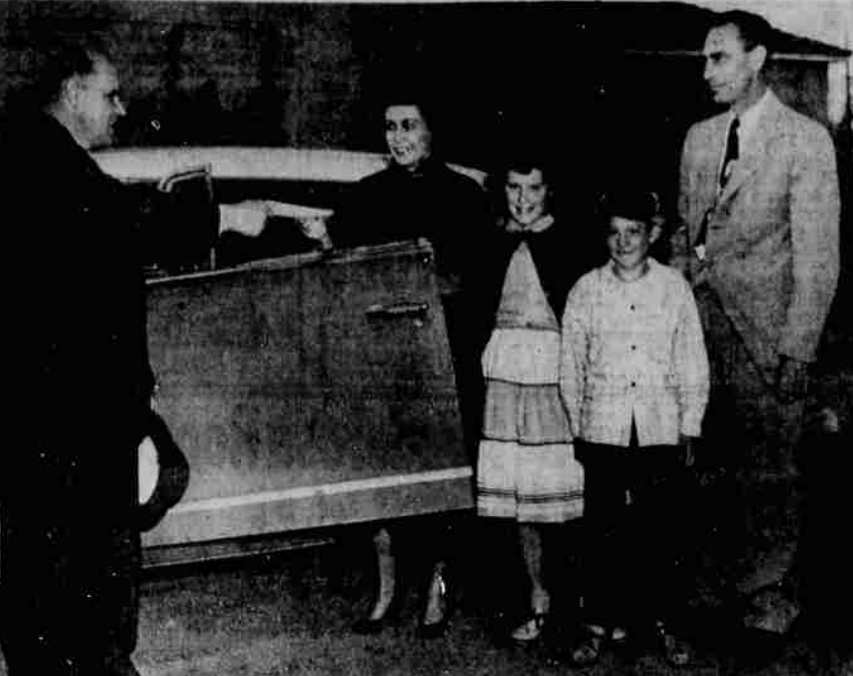


