Split-T Attacks Help Pros

PHILADELPHIA (AP) — Sammy Baugh once said that playing quarterback in the National Football League was like sitting in a rocking chair, the easiest way he knew of making a living.

Today's occupants of that so-called rocking chair are a lot different. To be a top flight quarterback in the NFL you have to run, not sit. The concept of quarterbacking among the pros has changed almost completely.

Baugh and Sid Luckman were two of the greatest—if not the greatest—ever to pitch a ball in the NFL. They played in the standard T-formation, moving back in to the pocket protected by bruising linemen. They didn't have to run, only pass.

Today, more and more of the pro coaches are adopting the split-T which calls for a versatile quarterback, one who can execute the option of pass or run. Those quarterbacks who don't run, with one or two exceptions, are pilot-losing teams.

The statistics issued each week by the NFL reveal that the pros are playing a new game. More and more are using the running game and their quarterbacks are helping to carry the ground gaining burden. The latest figures show six teams have gained more on the ground than through the air. Several others have recorded a fairly even balance between the run and pass.

The Chicago Bears, tied for the Western Conference lead and the total offense leader in the NFL, have gained more on the ground than in the air.

The revitalized Baltimore Colts have turned from a doormat to a title contender in the West. They have quarterback George Shaw, who in addition to passing, has gained 165 yards running.

San Francisco's Y. A. Tittle has 53 for 15. Frisco has been a pre-season title choice in the West for the past few years, just like the Eagles in the East. Neither team has been able to cash in. Neither has running quarterbacks.

Even the Los Angeles Rams, although they are tied for the Western Conference lead, have been unable to turn their great talent into a champion recently. Norm Van Brocklin is a top passer, but he's netted 21 yards, running with the ball.

It all adds up to the obvious fact: Pro football has turned from the aerial circus to a more fundamental attack. And the fans must like it, since attendance this year has reached new record proportions.

Speiser Scores TKO Win

CHICAGO (UP)—Light heavyweight Chuck Speiser had only one target today, a rematch with third ranked Willie Pastrano, after his convincing second round technical knockout of Paddy Young in the Chicago Stadium television fight.

"I don't know where we'll make it," Speiser's manager, Hec Knowles, said. "Maybe New Orleans. But we'll fight him anywhere we can get him and see how it comes out."

Speiser lost a 10-round decision to the 20-year-old Pastrano earlier this year, but both the fighter and most of the 1,411 observers rated the Detroit, Mich. scrapper "greatly improved" on his performance against Young.

"I've got confidence," Speiser explained. "I used to be a little, maybe unconsciously, to be fighting some of these guys. Why, I used to see Young fight when I was in college and (Willie) Troy too."

"But beating Troy gave me confidence and Young was just another fighter. He hit me a pretty good left hook, but that was all."

Young was lucky he connected with the left hook, in the first round, and the blow didn't seem to phase Speiser. He floored the New Yorker, who suffered his 12th defeat in 64 pro bouts, four times before the battle was ended with a technical knockout finish at 2:45 of the second.

Speiser put Young on the deck with a left hook in the first round and in the second session floored him three times before Referee Frank Glimmer stopped the brawl. Twice Young went down as the result of right hand punches and the third time after a left and a right.

Young, who said he was "too slow" in 168 pounds, said he was "going back to fighting middleweights." He appeared flabby in the ring.

PCL Directors In No Hurry To Name New Prexy

SACRAMENTO, Calif. (AP) — Directors of the Pacific Coast Baseball League are in no hurry to accept Clair Goodwin's resignation as league president, says president Fred David of the Sacramento Solons.

David said Wednesday he had talked by telephone with other directors and they agreed to wait until the Nov. 28 baseball meeting in Columbus, O., before making a decision.

David said Goodwin has done a "pretty fair job" since taking the \$20,000-a-year job a year ago.

David said he talked by phone with Leslie O'Connor, of Chicago, the league's attorney, now in Mexico, and that O'Connor said he would consider the presidency if offered.

O'Connor, who rejected the PCL presidency before Goodwin took it, again is reported the choice of several directors.
