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More Timber Sales Urged

SEATTLE (AP) — A congressional committee seeking an answer to the question of whether federal timber sales should be larger or smaller heard testimony favoring both viewpoints Tuesday.

Martin Lindell Jr., Stanwood, Wash., lumber processor, and T. F. Paulsen of the Mt. Adams Forest Products Co., White Salmon, Wash., urged that more timber be sold to the small operators.

A spokesman for the Scott Paper Co., called for consolidation of the small sales to strengthen the administrative power of the Forest Service.

The witnesses testified before a congressional subcommittee investigating federal timber policies.

Lindell told the committee small operators make better use of the forest. They remove small trees first, he said, while large operators damage the small trees by cutting the big ones first.

Paulsen said the small communities face a "serious problem" unless there are more small timber sales.

A Scott Paper Co. statement, read by Henry Goodhall, assistant manager of the company's timber division, said:

"By combining smaller sales into larger sales, much of this excessive (Forest Service) administrative work could be eliminated and by reason of larger sales, the total sale each year could be increased."

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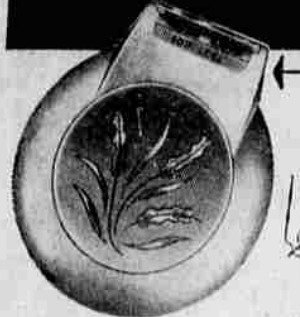
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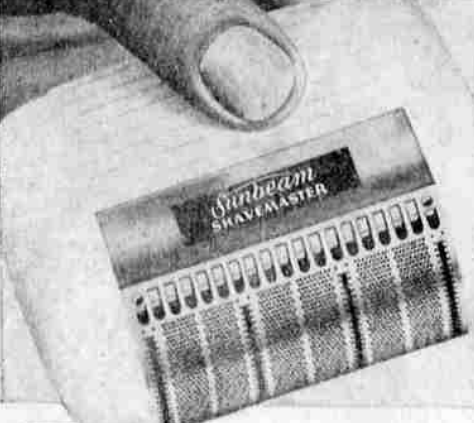
