Centennial Plans To Be Discussed

PORTLAND (AP) — Anthony Brandenthaler, chairman of the Oregon Centennial Commission, said plans for celebration of Oregon's 100th year as a state will be discussed here Dec. 2.

One of the topics, he said, would be consideration of what use may be made of the Portland Exposition-Recreation Center for a regional event—if the center is built by 1959, the centennial year. The site selected may play a part in what use is made of it by the commission, he said, adding that didn't mean any particular site was favored.

Brandenthaler, in his Tuesday comments, said Gov. Patterson is expected to attend the centennial commission meeting. Also to be invited, he said, were members of the Portland City Council, Portland Chamber of Commerce and the Exposition-Recreation Commission.

Britain Stalls On Bomb Ban

LONDON (AP) — Prime Minister Eden Wednesday stalled Labor demands that Britain accept Soviet Russia's call for an immediate worldwide ban on nuclear weapon tests.

He said Britain is "perfectly ready to consider" the proposal but warned Parliament against expecting unconditional British acceptance.

Eden said the terms of the Russian offer, broadcast from Moscow, "are far from clear." He commented it "might have appeared in a better light if it had been made before the recent Soviet explosion of which Mr. (Nikita) Khrushchev has spoken in such enthusiastic terms."

But Eden refused to commit the government on the proposal of Clement Attlee, Labor Party leader, that Britain initiate talks with the United States and Russia with a view to ending further experimental hydrogen bomb tests.
