

KUHS Principal To Attend San Francisco Conference

Charles Carlson, principal of Klamath Union High School, and Paul Angsted, assistant principal, will join approximately 350 leading school administrators and educators at the Western Invitational Conference on secondary school problems in the St. Francis Hotel, San Francisco, December 9.

Prominent educators, school and county superintendents, and state supervisors of education and guidance from California, Oregon, Washington, Utah, Montana, Nevada, and Colorado, will attend the meeting and discuss specific problems in reading-improvement and curriculum planning.

The all-day sessions of talks and workshops is sponsored by Science Research Associates, Chicago, one of the nation's leading publishers of educational testing, reading-improvement, and guidance materials.

Keynote speaker of the conference is Lyle M. Spencer, president of Science Research Associates. He will speak on "Emerging Problems of Secondary Schools."

Elizabeth A. Simpson, director of the reading service of the Institute for Psychological Services at the Illinois Institute of Technology, Chicago, and one of the outstanding authorities in the field of reading will open the morning session and talk on "Why Should High School Students Read Better?"

Dr. E. F. Lindquist, director of the Iowa Testing Programs, State University of Iowa, will discuss "New Developments in Achievement Testing."

Afternoon workshops on this topic include: "Individualizing instruction through achievement testing," "Evaluating curriculum through achievement testing," "Steps in planning an achievement testing program," "Uses and misuses of achievement tests," "New uses of the Iowa Tests of Educational Development."

Morning workshops on reading improvement topics include: "What are the steps in organizing a reading improvement program?" "To what extent should the high school

emphasize remedial reading?" "How can subject-matter teachers and students to read better?" "How can the administrator facilitate a high-school reading program?" "How can the high school aid ninth-grade students to become effective readers?"

Other speakers at the conference are Mrs. Esther Clark, reading specialist, Berkeley City High School and San Francisco State College, who will talk on "How Berkeley High School Helps Its Students Read Better," Mary Elizabeth Kenealy, supervisor, guidance and counseling, senior high school division, Los Angeles public schools, will discuss "How Los Angeles Uses Test Results."

Melvin Murphy To Address Medford Safety Conference

LOS ANGELES (AP)—Cartoonist Jimmy Murphy, 62, creator of "Toots and Casper," remained in critical condition today after a second heart attack. He entered St. Vincent's Hospital two weeks ago after the first attack.

Murphy is a graduate of Washburn University of Topeka, Kansas, and Denver University. His extensive background includes a position as executive director of the Mental Hygiene Society of North Carolina, positions with the University of Colorado Medical School, Kansas State Social Welfare Commission and similar work with the U.S. Army. He has worked with various industries in the development of mental health programs, including a realistic safety program.

"Injuries happen only to people," Murphy maintains. "The mechanical side of the picture is well-known for the most part. We need to know more about why a man is injured where the machine is not at fault."

The speech is to be part of the morning general session program. Registration is scheduled at 8:30 for the general public and delegates from all types of industry in Jackson, Josephine and Klamath counties.

Panel discussion groups on specific day-to-day industrial safety problems in Southern Oregon industry will be held in the afternoon. Panels for logging, sawmilling, plywood manufacturing, construction, utilities and one for other general industries have been arranged by the conference steering committee which is sponsoring the meeting with the assistance of the State Industrial Accident Commission.

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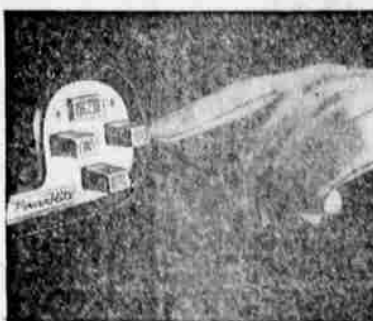
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
