



RADIATED ELECTRIC HEAT that provides the same kind of warmth as sunlight is being placed in the ceiling at the home of Mrs. Grace Wells, 2215 1/2 Orchard Avenue. The ceiling is being painted chartreuse to blend with the natural light wood finish of the walls. The only partition in the 33 by 22 foot room is at the rear and encloses the bathroom. 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Wood Products In Big Demand

Wood products, the manufacture of which is one of the Klamath Basin's major industries, play an important role in the construction of any house.

Even though the exterior finish might be of plaster, brick or concrete block, a large amount of the material in the completed dwelling had its origins in the forests.

Most houses, for example, have wood floors. Sometimes the actual wood floor is covered with linoleum or some other covering, but the basic floor is made of wood. Frames and joists are of wood—they might not show, but they are there.

Even in the extremely rare all-concrete and metal house, wood plays an important role. Scaffolding is often made of wood. Forms for the pouring of concrete are usually made of wood. Props and false work to support a part of the house until the rest of it is completed are often made of wood.

Finally, in any house, wood plays an important role in the decorations and trim. And about 90 per

cent of the furniture, outside of kitchen appliances and furnishings, is basically made of wood. Lumber and building supply firms
