### Kefauver Sees Calif. Freeze-Out

LOS ANGELES (UP)—Sen. Estes Kefauver (D-Tenn) says some California Democratic party leaders are trying to "freeze me out" of the state's presidential primary in June.

The senator made the charge last night before addressing a dinner of the Jewish National Fund. He said, however, despite the "freeze out, I don't discourage easily."

Kefauver said since arriving in California he has noted strong support in the state for the candidacy of Adlai Stevenson. But, he

said, he has "the same grass root support that I had before (1952), maybe a little more."

When questioned by reporters concerning whether he will become a candidate for the Democratic nomination, he said his political plans will be announced "shortly," not later than Jan. 15.

"If I run for anything, it will be for president—not vice president," he added.

In his speech before several hundred dinner guests, Kefauver said if the Communist nations continue to supply arms to Egypt, "we may have no alternative but to enable

Israel to buy sufficient arms to protect her sovereignty."

Kefauver declared in criticizing the government's foreign policy in the Middle East that "the United States needed a real foreign policy—one neither obscured in meaningless slogans nor rendered inef-
