

Reds Release Tenneson; Arrives In Hong Kong

HONG KONG (UP) — Richard P. Tenneson, 22, crossed into Hong Kong today from Communist China and said he turned his back on the United States because his step-father "used to beat and whip me" back in Alden, Minn.

The one-time private first class in the U. S. Army said he also chose Communism because he disagreed with Army policies and because he believed "a bunch of American Generals" practiced germ warfare during the Korean War.

Tenneson was one of 23 U. S. soldiers who were captured by the Chinese Communists during the Korean War and declined to re-

turn home when the fighting ended. Two changed their minds before the turncoats went to Red China. One died in Red China. Three changed their minds last July.

Tenneson said he had seen the remaining turncoats recently and "I guess they all will come back sometime." But he brought out a message from former Pvt. James G. Veneris of Hawthorne, Calif., that "I'll be in China another 13 years."

Peiping announced that Tenneson would be released on Nov. 30 but instead he became a pawn in the cold war. The Communists, in their drive for world recognition, would release him only to an American official and none could take him then.

Today he was "accepted" by American Red Cross Representative Richard Tomlin who was with British Representative Margaret Strathie, U. S. Consul S. M. Backe interviewed Tenneson briefly and said the turncoat was still an American citizen.

Tenneson was wearing a dark brown flannel suit and black shoes and carried a brown leather suit case. He boasted that the Chinese let him pick out the suit himself and that they paid for it. He had adopted Chinese manners and he smoked Chinese cigarettes.

American authorities placed him in a third class Hong Kong hotel until he leaves Thursday. He is expected to fly to Tokyo for a one hour stopover Thursday and board a Northwest Airlines plane for Seattle.
