Foundations For Holiday Wear

The formality of years past is back for the holiday season—late-day and evening fashions glitter in opulent fabrics. And underneath them will be worn equally elegant girdles and brassieres.

If you're a dress of rich, textured brocade, have a foundation in brocade satin elastic. Or if your holiday gown is of lace, a girdle and brassiere combining embroidery and lace with control. The colors of foundations, as well as the fabrics, are keyed to the outer fashions of the festive season. Your dress is black? Then choose black foundations — solid, sophisticated black, or black with the suggestion of color in pale pink or blue satin peeking through black lace. For jewel-tone foundations, there are jewel-tone foundations in red, blue, yellow, brown, ecru and green.

The reasons for coordination of foundations with fashions are a sound. First, you feel more festive, more feminine, in a coordinated costume. More important, your holiday fashions fit better when worn over foundations that shape a smooth silhouette.

Christmas Jewelry

Christmas bells will have to jingle louder this year if they're to be heard above the musical clamor of new fashion jewelry. Bracelets in particular, notes the Jewelry Industry Council, are coming by the jingling, shining arm load. In short, a fashionable lady should be heard as well as seen.

The reason for more noise is more bracelet. Links are larger in many of the new designs and so are charms, often set with lustrous mock pearls and shining imitation gems. There's more pin, too, after many a season of smaller proportions. Newest pins and clips are importantly sized and imaginatively designed. Among them you'll find a Maltese Cross decorated with brown enamel, a swirling autumn leaf lighted with a rhinestone dewdrop, or a shaggy daisy centered with a bright green stone.

Because of the popularity of high, wide necklines this winter, the base-of-the-throat necklace is an important accent. Many of the beaded or simple chain necklaces can be arranged in scarf-like fashion, bunched or looped casually to form a bright jeweled focal point where it is most flattering. Simple, back-swept hair styles call for larger earrings, be they buttons, domes, clusters, contours, showers or dangles.

In tailored and daytime jewelry styles, gold-colored metal is a leader, often set with smoky stones or green, dark blue and garnet red or with ribbons or rhinestones. Gleaming gold filled pins, earrings and other pieces are also available in a variety of styles, some tailored and some to be worn with elegant lacy costumes.

WINE-FLAVORED EGG CHEESE

With a generous supply of thin, crisp crackers in the cupboard and a wine-flavored Edam cheese in the refrigerator, you're all set for unexpected guests this holiday season. To prepare the cheese, cut a shallow cone out of the top of the Edam and with an ice pick or skewer, honeycomb the inside of the cheese with holes, being very careful not to perforate the rind. Pour in as much port wine as the cheese will hold. Store in the refrigerator at least a week—two weeks is better. Add more wine as the cheese absorbs it.

WHITE TRIM

A trick to remember for white trimmings: Iron with the straight edge of the material. This keeps linings flat. To make sure that the lining does not roll over and show from the top side, run large basting stitches around the edges of collars and cuffs before washing; remove while pressing.
