



CLOSE-UP OF "Tinsel Eyes" make-up especially created for this holiday season by the famous Helena Rubinstein's Make-Up Director Rod Barron. Platinum Eye Shadow Stick (the "tinsel" in the title) is applied to the outer eye corners and lashes, the contour of the mouth and to fill in the diamond beauty mark on the forehead.

SPARKLE

Don't be afraid of glitter this Christmas, advises Rod Barron, make-up director for Helena Rubinstein. He suggests the festive "Tinsel Eyes Look" for this holiday season.

This is how you go about it: Apply Silk-Tone Foundation in a shade that will give your skin a soft, luminous look — the effect of holiday candlelight, and then finish with English Silk Complexion Powder in a shade to blend with the foundation.

Now, the eyes — the point of emphasis and the center of attention: with Everpoint Eye Pencil in black, line the upper lid close to the lashes from the inner corner slightly past the center, and then draw the line higher on the lid, gradually away from the roots of the lashes and extended an inch beyond the outer corner. Line the lower lid then, close to the lashes all the way across from inner to outer corner, and bring the line up to meet the one extended from the upper lid, leaving about a quarter of an inch of space between the two lines.

At this point comes the piece de resistance! With Platinum Eye Shadow Stick (the "tinsel" of the title), and a clean lipstick brush, fill in between the two lines described above. Begin this on the upper lid at the point where the eyeliner began to rise from the root of the lashes, and continue to fill in the space at the outer corner. Then wipe the lipstick brush clean and use it to apply Blue-Green Eye Shadow Stick on the entire eyelid, from inner to outer corner.

On the lashes, use Black Waterproof Mascara, from the inner to the outer corner of the upper lashes. Then apply the Platinum Eye Shadow — that's right, eye shadow — with the mascara brush on the outer corner of the eyelashes. This, with the filled-in area previously applied, gives you the most star-like eyes you've ever seen!

Eyebrows should be drawn with soft, feathery strokes to make the brow into a full, high arch with a slight flare upward at the ends. Use a Dark Brown Everpoint Eye Pencil.

And now the mouth: Outline it first with — we mean it! — the same Platinum Eye Shadow you used on the eyes. Use a lipstick brush, to get into the corners. Then fill in with lipstick, preferably of a deep red, but of course to blend with your costume.

You're not finished with Platinum Eye Shadow yet! Now you use it for the finishing touch to your festive face, a diamond beauty mark. First, draw a diamond shape in the center of the forehead, about a quarter of an inch in width and length, with Black Eyebrow Pencil, and then fill it in with the silvery eye shadow, using a lipstick brush.

It remains only to touch up your hair with Silver Touch, for the picture to be complete. Starting in the middle of the browline, and "spraying" out toward the crown, use Silver Touch to give the effect of a shooting star.

That's it. Don't blame the Christmas tree if its radiance dims when you enter the room, just enjoy your reign as the star of the show — and glow, and glow, and glow and glow!

Ship Passes Successful Test

SAN FRANCISCO (UP) — The USS Tulare, largest and most modern attack cargo ship in the world, has successfully completed her builder's trials and will be commissioned in mid-January, 12th Naval District headquarters announced today.

Named after Tulare County, the 18,000-ton vessel has a speed of more than 22 knots. It is equipped with a helicopter landing platform on the stern, has masts and booms capable of lifting 60-ton landing craft to aid from the sea, and the most powerful armament of any attack transport in the fleet.

The Tulare, built at Bethlehem Pacific's San Francisco yards, will carry 27 landing craft.

Decorations Warning Given

PORTLAND (AP) — The State Board of Health warned Wednesday against use of so-called flameproofing material for Christmas trees.

Oregon State College forestry department issued a similar caution.

Both said that there is no commercial product which will lessen fire hazard in evergreen trees. Borax solutions, widely recommended for fireproofing, actually increase inflammability of trees. Janice Westaby, home safety consultant for the health board, said.

Charles Ross, farm forestry specialist at OSC, said a deep diagonal cut in the tree stem will make a greater area for water absorption when the tree is placed in a container filled with water.

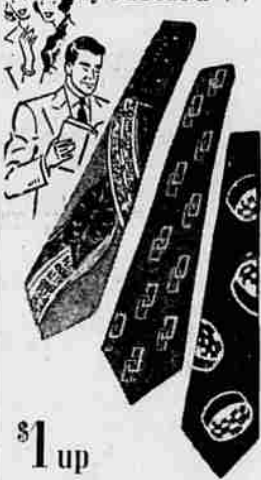
BLANCHED ALMONDS

Seed Growers Ask Program

SALEM (AP) — Thirty-one Jefferson County ladino seed growers petitioned Wednesday to have a commodity commission to promote their product.

The petitioners, who grew seed on 1,084 acres this year, made their request of the State Department of Agriculture.

Paul T. Rowell, chief of the new

division of market development in the Department of Agriculture, said hearing dates on the petition would be set soon.

This is the second seed group to ask for a commission under the 1953 law enabling creation of such groups. The Chewings' Pecan and Creeping Red Fescue Commission recently was set up under that law.

The ladino growers say they need a commission to conduct research, promote the industry through advertising, and to study state and federal laws relating to the commodity.

'Rights Day' Set By Ike

GETTYSBURG, Pa. (AP) — President Eisenhower Wednesday called the attention of all Americans to "the most precious of liberties" — those contained in the Bill of Rights.

The President issued a statement for Bill of Rights Day, which will be observed Thursday. It said in part:

"Bill of Rights Day ranks in the forefront of our days of commemoration. On this day, the people of America remember and honor the passage of the Bill of Rights—the first ten amendments to the Constitution.

"By the Bill of Rights our people are guaranteed the most precious of liberties. These rights, indispensable to our happiness and security, reaffirm our belief in the dignity of the individual.

"On this day I hope that citizens throughout our land will renew in their hearts and minds a devotion to these freedoms and a determination to defend them against all forms of attack. Let us also highly resolve to continue to strive for a peaceful world in which all mankind will share them."

Coogan and Hayden sued Telemont for the 5 per cent and the corporation's demand for damages was made in a countersuit yesterday.

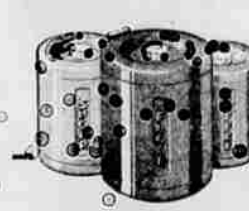

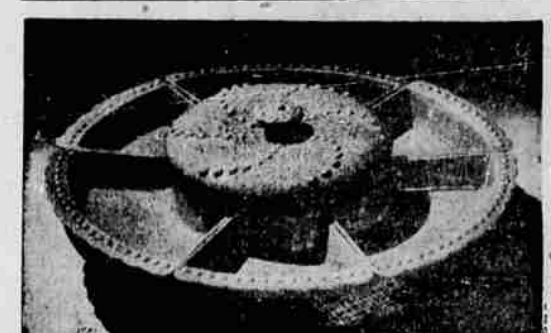
