

United Fund Work Clarified

Paul Campbell, chairman of the Klamath County Christmas Clearing Bureau, clarified their work and the role of the United Fund today. Campbell said, "The Christmas Clearing Bureau was founded so that the people of Klamath County might be in a better position to fulfill their desires in being assured that those needing help would have a happy Christmas."

"Individuals, groups, and organizations who wish to help others at Christmas," Campbell stated, "check with the Clearing Bureau to make sure their efforts will not be duplicated."

The second phase of the Clearing Bureau's work is to receive calls of individuals desiring some assistance for the Christmas season. Campbell said: "In most cases these calls are made by neighbors or interested friends of those needing some assistance."

Programs such as the Fremont Junior High Industrial Arts class also can be cleared through the bureau.

"The United Fund office," Campbell related, "made their telephone available for the Clearing Bureau's work this year. They keep the files and take all phoned in information. The United Fund, as an organization, is in no way able to give direct assistance."

Furstenburg, who several years ago was injured while haying for Fisher, claims he had been paid by the state accident commission but said that Fisher still owed him something.

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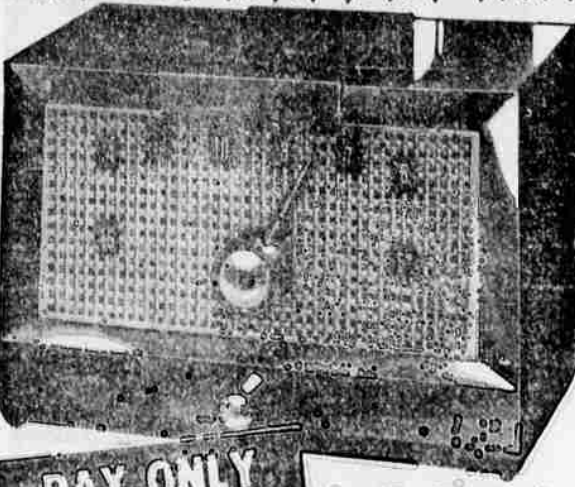

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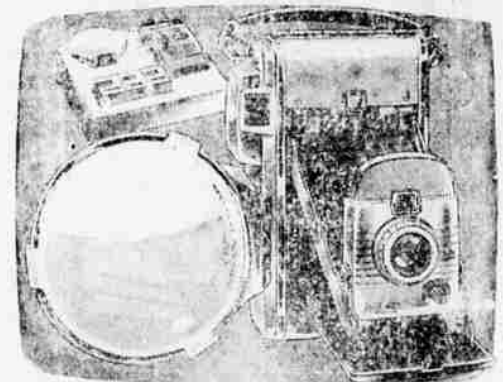
