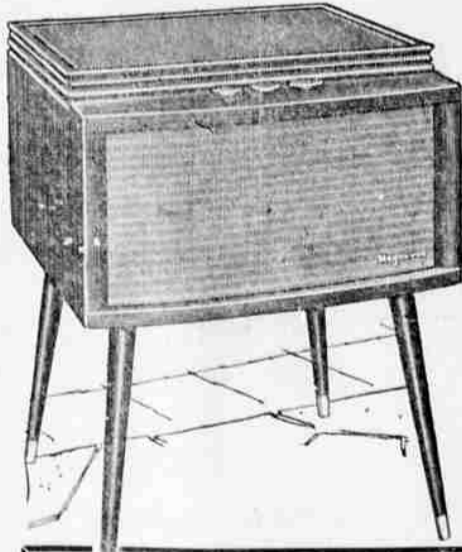

Kefauver Honing For Fight With Stevenson In Coming New Hampshire Balloting

Sen. Estes Kefauver, whose 1952 campaign for the Democratic presidential nomination got its biggest early boost in New Hampshire, wants to battle with Adlai Stevenson in that state's support in 1956.

There was no immediate word from Stevenson but one of his supporters, John Rogers Penn, said he would seek election as a New Hampshire convention delegate pledged to Stevenson whether or not the 1952 nominee enters the contest.

Kefauver announced yesterday he is entering the New Hampshire primary and expressed hope "the snow and ice will not deter" Stevenson.

Stronger hints came from friends of Sen. William F. Knowland (R-Calif.), the Senate minority leader, that he might not wait for announcement of President Eisenhower's political plans to enter some primary on his own.

The friends said Knowland is convinced Eisenhower will not run, and reported he has sent directly to Eisenhower his contention that he would be mid-February or later other GOP aspirants cannot afford to get their names on primary ballots.

Dr. Paul Dudley White, the Boston heart specialist who examined Eisenhower Saturday, said it would be mid-February or later Eisenhower could be sure he is physically able to seek a second term if he wants one.

Guatemala Vote Results Revealed

GUATEMALA (AP)—The National Democratic Movement (MDN) of President Carlos Castillo Armas announced its victory today in Guatemala's congressional elections.

The victory announcement was no surprise. All candidates in yesterday's balloting for the 66 seats in Congress had promised to support the anti-Communist leader of the revolution which ousted President Jacobo Arben Guzman, his Red-dominated regime 18 months ago.

MDN candidates were mostly unopposed except for entries of the equally pro-government National Anti-Communist Front in some areas. The Communist party was outlawed.
