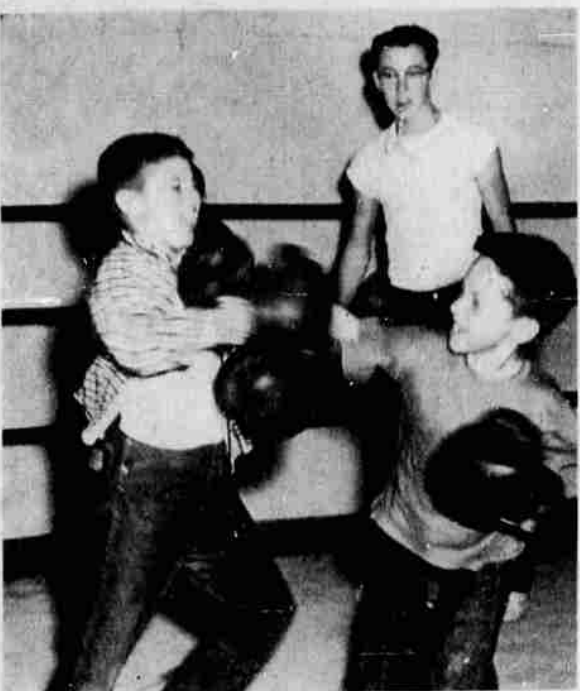

Sealed proposals will be received by the Common Council of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, for the purchase of street improvement bonds, Series 101, in the sum of \$1,761,784, duly authorized by ordinance of the said City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, for the construction and improvement of the following described improvement unit situated in the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, to-wit:

Improvement Unit No. 124, extending along the alley in Block 4, Canal Addition, to City of Klamath Falls, Oregon.

Proposals to purchase said bonds will be received by the undersigned up to and including the 16th day of January, 1956, at the hour of seven thirty o'clock p.m. of said day and opened at a regular meeting of the Common Council immediately thereafter; said bonds shall be dated February 1, 1956, and shall be in amounts of \$500.00 each, except bond No. 1, which shall be for the fractional part of said sum, and all shall be due ten years after date of issue, payment of the entire bond optional with said City at any option paying date on and after one year from the date thereof. Said bonds will bear interest at a rate of not to exceed six per cent per annum, payable semi-annually on February 1st and August 1st of each year, principal and interest payable at the office of the treasurer of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon.
