Fruit Squares

Here is Nancy Haven's recipe of the month, using Beet Sugar.

- 1 cup sugar
- 2 eggs
- 1/2 cup shortening, melted
- 1/2 cup cut-up mixed candied fruits
- 1/2 cup broken walnut meats
- 1/2 cup sifted all-purpose flour
- 1/2 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1/2 teaspoon cloves

Generously grease an 8 - inch square pan and set aside.

In mixing bowl, beat eggs until thick and lemon colored. Gradually add sugar, continuing to beat. Stir in melted shortening; then all at once, add prepared fruits, nut meats and sifted dry ingredients. Spread thick batter out in prepared pan.

Bake in a slow oven (325 degrees) about 45 minutes, or until a toothpick thrust into the center comes out clean. Cool slightly in pan; cut into squares. When cold remove from pan and dust with powdered sugar. Yield: 16 squares.

SALAD TOPPING

A little grated onion, finely chopped fresh cranberries and minced parsley mixed with a simple oil and vinegar French dressing is an excellent dressing for a sliced avocado and grapefruit section salad—makes it look extra pretty and most inviting.

Don't be surprised if your powder alone appears light at the outset for after wearing it twenty minutes the natural oil from your skin and foundation deepens the tone.

It's important to start the day with a foundation to give your powder a smooth, even base to cling to. Once you've carefully applied your foundation to your neck and face, blend in your rouge and you're ready for the initial powder. ... and we do it in a way that's the secret behind long lasting make-up. Saturate your puff with powder and press it firmly onto the skin. Pay special attention to the tiny expression lines on the face. Simply hold the skin taut while you press the powder onto the fine lines. When the skin is relaxed the lines no longer present a contrasting dark tone against the powdered face and seem to disappear. After the powder has "set" for a few minutes dust off the excess. Now you have a clear, smooth surface for the palette of make-up colors to war on your eyes, and lips. Work toward naturalness when painting these colors on for this is the final step to your well-coordinated look that begins with make-up chosen for your individual coloring.

SWEET POTATO SALAD

Pile the salad to the season and feature sweet potatoes. Ham joins the succulent sweet in this salad, and is blended with pickle, mayonnaise, and a delicate mixture of herbs in a dressing made from an envelope of salad dressing mix. Spicy and nice, the end result makes a tasty winter dish that can rival the old summertime favorite, Irish potato salad.

Treat the "sweets" gently, for they bruise easily. Boil them covered until tender, then drain. At once so they won't get waterlogged. Cool, then dice or slice for salad use.

SWEET POTATO SALAD

1 package California French Salad Dressing Mix Vinegar, water, oil
2 cups (1 pound) diced or sliced cooked sweet potatoes
2-3 cup (1/2 pound) diced or sliced cooked ham
1/2 cup mayonnaise
1/2 cup mixed dressing
Dash of salt
1/4 cup chopped sweet or dill pickle

Combine salad dressing mix, vinegar, water and oil as directed on the bottle or package.
Combine potatoes and ham. Blend mayonnaise, 1/2 cup of the dressing and salt. Pour over potato mixture; toss several times. Chill. Garnish with pickle. Makes 3 cups or 2 or 3 servings luncheon or entree salad.

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ROASTED TURKEY

The new Associated Press business representative for this area, Tom Aden, has a southern accent which comes straight from Tennessee.

During his pre-holiday trip to Klamath Falls, he was drooling all ready for turkey the way his wife's mother roasts it for the holidays. At our request, he mailed us the recipe upon his return home. Here it is:

"Melt 1/2 pound butter and mix flour with it to make a paste.

Salt this slightly. If the turkey is dry, moisten it slightly, then smear the paste all over it. Melt the other quarter pound of butter in a cup of hot water. Pour this in the pan for basting.

"Start the turkey in an oven of 450 degrees, cook for about an hour then turn the heat down to 350 degrees. Baste the turkey every hour.

"Cook with the roaster lid on all the time until the last 30 minutes or hour during which time the cover is removed to brown the bird.

"That's all there is to it, she says. ... makes a mighty succulent dish."

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
