

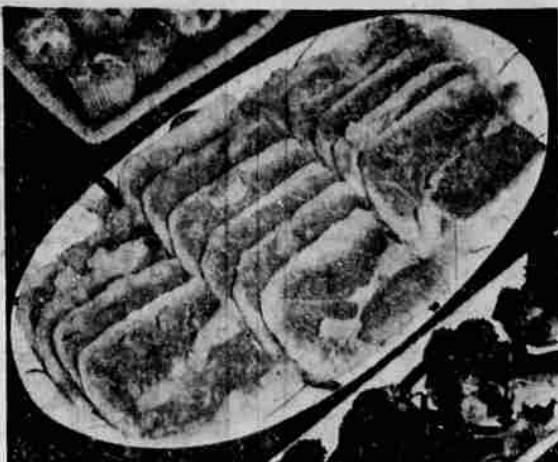

AN ELEGANT CANNED HAM which needs no preparation time can be the feature of any meal. The canned ham, of course, is fully cooked so you can serve it as is, or heat it through, if you prefer. Photograph and suggestions from Martha Logan Test Kitchens of Swift and Company.

CANNED HAM

Fully cooked canned hams now range from 1 1/2 to 13 pounds which means you can buy just the size you need for the family or for company. They've saved many a hostess from embarrassment when her cocktail party guests were more numerous and hungrier than anticipated.
These hams are boneless so you can plan on using all of the meat you purchase with no waste. Select a quality, branded canned ham so you can be sure of fine flavor and texture.
To serve one of these hams, simply remove it from the can and slice it cold for cold service, or score and glaze the surface if you wish to heat it through. You can serve canned ham sliced on cold meat trays or for hearty sandwiches. And leftovers are wonderful diced and added to scrambled eggs, potato or vegetable salads. If you do serve the ham cold, be sure to save the jelly to use in making gravies and sauces or for part of the liquid in a ham loaf.
For a hot, glazed ham, place the ham, fat side up, on a rack in an open pan and pour the natural jelly over it. Heat in a slow

oven (325 degrees) 10 to 15 minutes a pound. Then score the fat into diamond shapes, cover with brown sugar and brown in a hot oven.
Here is a recipe from Swift and Company which features canned ham that has been sliced and heated in an apricot sauce.
HAM TROPICALE
(24 servings)
1 six-pound canned ham, cut into 1/4-inch slices
1 can (2 cups) canned apricots, drained
1 can (2 cups) canned pineapple tidbits, drained
1/4 cup butter
Mash apricots, combine with pineapple tidbits, butter and juice from apricots and pineapple. Heat. Place sliced ham in bottom of broiler pan or large baking pan. Cover with fruit sauce. Heat in a hot oven (400 degrees) about 20 minutes. Serve hot. Don't serve sweet vegetables with this dish or you'll have a "sweet meal."
CANNED HAM
1 six-pound canned ham
1 glass peach jam (6 to 8 oz.)



Remove ham from can. Scrape off jelly. Cut ham into 1/4-inch slices. Tie slices together loosely and place in a baking dish. Serve, cut string and place ham slices on platter.

FRUITED PUDDINGS

- 1/4 cup seedless raisins
- 1/2 cup candied cherries, quartered
- 3 tablespoons diced, candied orange peel
- 3 tablespoons diced, candied citron
- 3 tablespoons diced, candied lemon peel
- 1/4 cup pureed unsweetened cooked prunes
- 1/4 cup pureed unsweetened cooked dried apricots
- 1/2 cup chopped walnuts
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1 teaspoon each cinnamon, nutmeg and allspice
- 1/2 cup orange juice
- 1 tablespoon brandy
- 2 envelopes (2 tablespoons) unflavored gelatine
- 1/4 cup cold water
- 1 1/2 cups whipping cream

European Airlines To Purchase Jets

SEATTLE (AP) — Two European air lines, Air France and Belgian Sabena World Airlines, Wednesday announced purchase of 13 Boeing jet transports for nearly \$1 million dollars.
Air France bought 10 of the Boeing 707s for about \$71,500,000, and also signed an option for an additional undisclosed number.
Sabena purchased three for \$15,450,000.
