



Mishaps Claim 59 In Canada

TORONTO, Ont. (AP)—Violent death claimed 59 lives in Canada during the New Year holiday weekend.

Thirty-seven persons were killed in traffic accidents and 14 died in fires, a Canadian Press survey showed. The count covered the 78-hour period from 8 p.m. Friday to midnight Monday.

Last year 35 persons were killed within the same holiday period, including 9 in highway and street accidents and 7 in fires.

The 1955 three-day Christmas holiday weekend ended with a toll of 65 violent deaths.

Many American Tourists Plan Travel To Russia

NEW YORK (AP)—Despite the recent return to cold war bitterness, travel agencies here report many American tourists are interested in visiting the Soviet Union this year.

A trickle of ordinary American travelers got to Moscow in 1955, more than in any year since World War II. Not since the 1930s have Americans journeyed to the U.S.S.R. in appreciable numbers.

But now—unless there's a new war scare or a reversal in Kremlin policy—it looks as if the Soviet government is going to have a fair-sized try at taking in tourist dollars which have meant so much to Western Europe.

One travel agency says it is getting 50 inquiries a day from Americans who want to take a trip to

Russia. Another is now scheduling an air excursion each month to the Soviet Union. The motive of the customers, they consider, is mainly just plain curiosity.

American Express has received so many questions on Russian travel it has issued special instructions to its offices all over the country on how to answer them. Cosmos Tours, Union Tours and Thomas Cook report a flood of similar inquiries.

None will give a specific estimate of how many Americans will go to the Soviet Union under its auspices. But Cosmos Tours and Union Tours both express confidence they will have "some hundreds" before the year is out.

Union Tours is inaugurating this month its first monthly 15-person junket to Russia and back. Each

trip will last 17 days, including about two weeks in Russia. Charges will be \$1,450 or \$1,251, depending on whether the traveler uses first or tourist class plane passage across the Atlantic.

Cosmos Tours is actively engaged in selling more than a dozen different journeys inside the Soviet Union. One of them provides five days in Moscow and five in Leningrad at a price of \$300 in the deluxe class. Transportation to and from Russia is extra.

American Express is scheduling several small groups for tours of 12 to 14 days this summer.

Thomas Cook is booking two tours for 25 persons each for the summer.

The Soviet Union may consider it has a classless society, but for tourists it has worked out five different classes, ranging from deluxe down to third class. The deluxe tours cost roughly \$30 a day, including hotels, meals, transportation and sightseeing.

E. Kefauver Urges Slight Tax Slashes

WASHINGTON (UP)—Democratic presidential candidate Estes Kefauver says he wants election-year tax cuts for the "voters."

The Tennessee senator said although he is against any "great" tax reduction, "we ought to give a small additional exemption to voters" if a tax cut is feasible.

He said part of the revenue loss could be regained from higher taxes on stockholders.

Kefauver, in a radio interview, also said he is seriously considering entering the Florida and Minnesota primaries against Adlai E. Stevenson.

Kefauver said there is "quite a field" of issues on which Democrats will differ with Republicans in the election-year session of the 84th Congress, which began today.

Kefauver said he favors a "substantial" increase in foreign economic aid this year. Asked whether this might rule out a tax cut, he said "that may be the situation."

But if it is possible to make a reduction, he said, then he thinks voters should be given a small increase in their \$600 income tax exemption.

He proposed repealing the special tax dividend credit granted stockholders by the Republican-controlled 83rd Congress.

Kefauver was asked whether he meant to include "non-voters" as well as "voters" in his proposed tax cut. He said everybody "ought to be a voter" and he has heard it argued that "if they don't vote maybe they ought to pay a little more tax."

However, an aide said later that Kefauver meant the proposed cut to apply to all taxpayers and not just to those exercising their voting privilege.

He listed the top issues in Congress as farm, housing, resource development, social security, education, school construction, and "the way our foreign policy is being carried out." He said the conduct of foreign affairs will be a major issue in the presidential election campaign.
