Education Meeting Delegate Reports To Soroptimists

Mrs. Victor E. O'Neill, appointee-delegate of Governor Paul Patterson to the White House Conference on Education held in Washington, D.C. in November of last year, is not in favor of proposed federal aid to schools.

Mrs. O'Neill, member of the Oregon State Board of Education, speaker before the Klamath Falls Soroptimist Club on January 5, agreed with the minority of the 1,800 official delegates present, that educational problems should be worked out at grassroots levels.

Although no official vote on the proposal was taken, sentiment in favor of federal aid for schools was two to one around the conference table, Mrs. O'Neill stated. She gave as two reasons for her opinion, (1) opposition to more centralized control in the federal government and, (2) the burdening of financially secure states such as Oregon with taxes that would benefit states with financial deficits.

Delegates considered the six major educational questions facing school officials: (1) What is the role of the school? (2) How can we get the school facilities we need? (3) How can we get enough good teachers and keep them? (4) How can we organize our school

Systems Most Efficiently and Economically? (5) How Can We Pay For Our Schools? (6) How Can We Obtain a Continuing Public Support in Education?

The present crisis in the shortage of school facilities and teachers is acute and must be worked out to the advantage of all concerned, the speaker stated.

Questions of segregation and the teaching of religion in the schools were sidestepped at the conference.

Mrs. O'Neill stated that a "great amount of good will" came out of the conference, and announced a general post-conference to be held in Klamath County at a later date.

Mrs. O'Neill was one of 13 delegates from Oregon appointed by Governor Paul Patterson. Leading educators and others raised the delegation to 30.

She was introduced by Ruth O'Hara, Soroptimist program chairman for the meeting.

Mary Bothwell, ticket sales chairman for the Civic Dramatic Guild plays to be presented here this winter and next spring, announced that the date of the first play, "The Letter" has been postponed from January 10 to May 23 due to illness of the lead.

The January 12 meeting will be a business session.
