Calfee first had the mantle of glory draped over him when he out-dissuaded a former university track star, turned prohibition agent in a two-mile sprint through the Great Smoky Mountains of Tennessee.

The two-time hero was acclaimed again for valorous deeds aboard the heavy cruiser USS Pittsburgh during World War II. Calfee, then a damage control officer, won the Legion of Merit for lighting an electrical fire in the anchor windless room after the bow of the battle wagon was ripped off by a thunderous sea in a typhoon near Guam.
