**Add-A-Shelf Idea
Ups Storage Room**

If you are "starved" for shelf space in your kitchen, but don't have room for additional cabinets, the Western Pine Association offers this space-saving tip:

For supports, cut two pieces of three-quarter-inch stock as long as

the width of the new shelf. Install them with screws on the inside walls of the cabinet far enough up to give headroom for tall items to be stored on the original shelf, but not so far as to cramp storage on the new shelf. Then cut a pine board the width of the cabinet and nail it down to the supports.

You'll be surprised how many small glasses, cups, or small pantry items this extra shelf will hold.

BUY LUMBER "SHORTS"

For small wood-working projects, short lengths of lumber often may be obtained from your lumber yard at a special low price. The Western Pine Association points out that spice racks, shelves, bird houses and valance boards are just a few of the items for which lumber shorts are useful.

Douglas Fir Creates Fine Background For Designers

Like the brush stroke of an artist, nature has created in the wonderful texture, grain and coloring of woods like Douglas fir, a vehicle of incomparable beauty for the modern designer. Elsie Doty Sopp, A.I.D., says paneled walls of fir offer striking background for color, fabric and furnishings when creating a home in the modern mood.

Mrs. Sopp, prominent West Coast interior decorator, suggests just one of many decorating themes which allies itself perfectly with paneling of natural close-grained Douglas fir:

First the decorator lifts the tawny copper grain directly from the paneling and makes it an essential part of upholstery color. Along with a soft avocado green and rich browns, the copper becomes an integral tone in chair and davenport covers.

A high-style hand blocked print for the draperies, once more incorporating the three major colors, is effective. The "Famous Actors" cotton fabric has a diamond motif of deep copper, with the four figures—Harlequin, Pantaloon, Clown and Sprite—imprinted in shades of muted copper, antique green, brick rose and white. These characters are large and may be cut from the fabric and framed behind glass for a surprising picture grouping.

A startling innovation in floor covering is the new copper and brass inlays in square, round or Chinese diamond tiles. Heavy-weight vinyl tiles in marbled copper and brown tones, or a ter-

razzo vinyl tile, with the Chinese diamond copper inlays at strategic intervals will keep eyes glued to the floor. Under it all—hemlock flooring for resilient walking surface, important to the busy housewife.

For a nubby, deep-pile esthetic bit of comfort beneath your feet, a good sized Moroccan hand-woven rug will carry out the room's color ensemble and exile a conversation grouping.

Lamp bases of pottery with that natural stone-y look under plain parchment shades accents the tableau. If you wish to color your parchment shades, this is easy for anyone to do. Oil colors, obtainable in tubes in an art supply store, rubs right into the shade in any color you like. Natural parchment bound in olive green is also smart.
