Neuberger Urges Vet Restoration

WASHINGTON (AP)—Restoration of educational benefits for veterans was proposed Wednesday by Sen. Neuberger (D-Ore.) as "a matter of simple justice for our soldiers."

In a Senate speech prepared to accompany introduction of his bill, Neuberger said the United States is stationing servicemen in spots "which are either unpleasant as localities in which to live or in close juxtaposition to our possible foes."

"Why should these boys," he asked, "be denied the GI Bill benefits which went during World War II to many servicemen who never left the shores of the United States?"

Neuberger said he was joined in introducing the bill by Sens. Morse (D-Ore.), Magnuson (D-Wash.), Margaret Chase Smith and Payne (R-Maine), Mansfield (D-Mont.) and McNamara (D-Mich.).

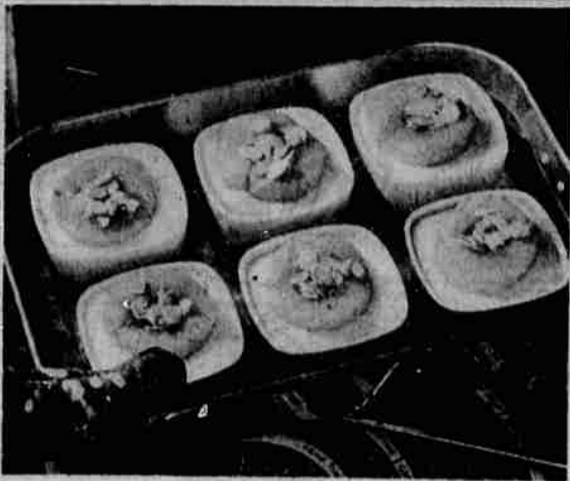

CUSTARD VARIATIONS

Most homemakers like to have baked cup custards on hand for easy desserts. Sometimes, there is resistance from some members of the family to plain cup custard. If this happens in your family, try adding spice, or placing a few spice drops or nuts in the bottom of the custard cup before pouring in the custard mixture. Another interesting flavor can be achieved by placing a little brown sugar in the bottom of the cup. The result will be a caramel flavored custard.

A new way of dressing up the highly nutritious cup custard is to place well drained peach halves with some slivered almonds on the top, about 10 minutes before the baking is completed. This will make a delicious dessert and one that will find favor with all.

Custards made with milk and eggs provide abundant protein of the highest quality, also calcium from the milk and iron from the eggs, plus many other minerals and vitamins. Using milk as an ingredient in cooking as well as for drinking is an excellent way to increase milk's nutrients in meals. Baked
