ON FEBRUARY 14, 1926 Mrs. J. U. Babcock joined the firm and has been with it ever since.

IN 1928 Klamath County Abstract Company became affiliated with Pacific Title Insurance Co. of Portland, underwriters of title insurance policies . . . just one of the many steps the
